Authorized the State School Superintendent to award a grant to the Georgia Professional Standards Commission (GaPSC) at a cost not to exceed \$1,012,393.00 in Federal funds for providing technical assistance to Local Educational Agencies (LEAs).

#### **OTHER BUSINESS**

Mrs. Zechmann asked that the following statement be recorded in the minutes:

We have observed inconsistencies in the application for waivers at the local level, specifically at the school level. We need to communicate the SBOE expectation for demonstrating the mastery of content with greater clarity. The need for greater clarification is evident by the wide disparity in the waiver requests that we receive. Some are clear and compelling and a waiver is granted. Many very clearly do not meet the SBOE expectation for content mastery. Therefore we recommend the development of a clear and concise communication about the waiver process, perhaps in the form of a PowerPoint presentation, and that said communication piece be reviewed by the SBOE to assure that it aligns with SBOE expectations. We recommend that this communication be disseminated to all stakeholders via an Elluminate session and be archived on the DOE website for future reference.

It was agreed that the draft waiver communication would be presented to the board at the November 2011 meeting.
