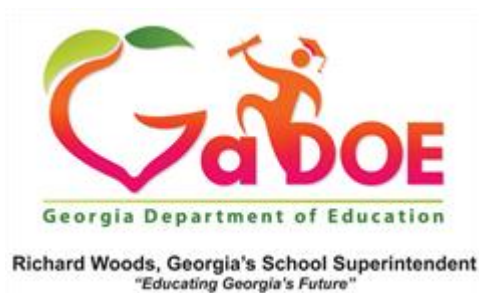

Brief History of Charter Schools in Georgia

Georgia's first charter school law was passed in 1993. It allowed for the creation of conversion charter schools only and Georgia's first three conversion charter schools were approved in 1995. The charter school law was expanded in 1998, allowing for both locally-approved and state chartered special schools. Oglethorpe Charter School was the first locally-approved start-up charter school. It opened in the Savannah-Chatham County School System and is still operating today. In 2001, the first two state chartered special schools opened, Charter Conservatory for Liberal Arts and Technology (CCAT) and Odyssey School, which added Georgia's first virtual school -- the Georgia Cyber Academy -- as a program in 2007. In 2008, the charter law was changed to establish the Georgia Charter Schools Commission, with the first Commission schools opening in 2009. In 2011, the Georgia Supreme Court ruled the Commission law unconstitutional, but in 2012 a constitutional amendment was overwhelmingly approved by Georgia voters to allow for a new State Charter Schools Commission (SCSC). The first members of the SCSC were appointed by the State Board of Education in 2013 and they have been busy working to create high quality state charter schools since then.

2018-19 Charter Schools

Georgia now has 110 charter schools serving students statewide. There are 8 Conversion Charter Schools, including 2 Georgia College and Career Academies. There are 73 locally-approved start-up charter schools, including 22 Georgia College and Career Academies. Finally, there are 29 State Charter Schools operating this year, with 6 more scheduled to open in 2019.

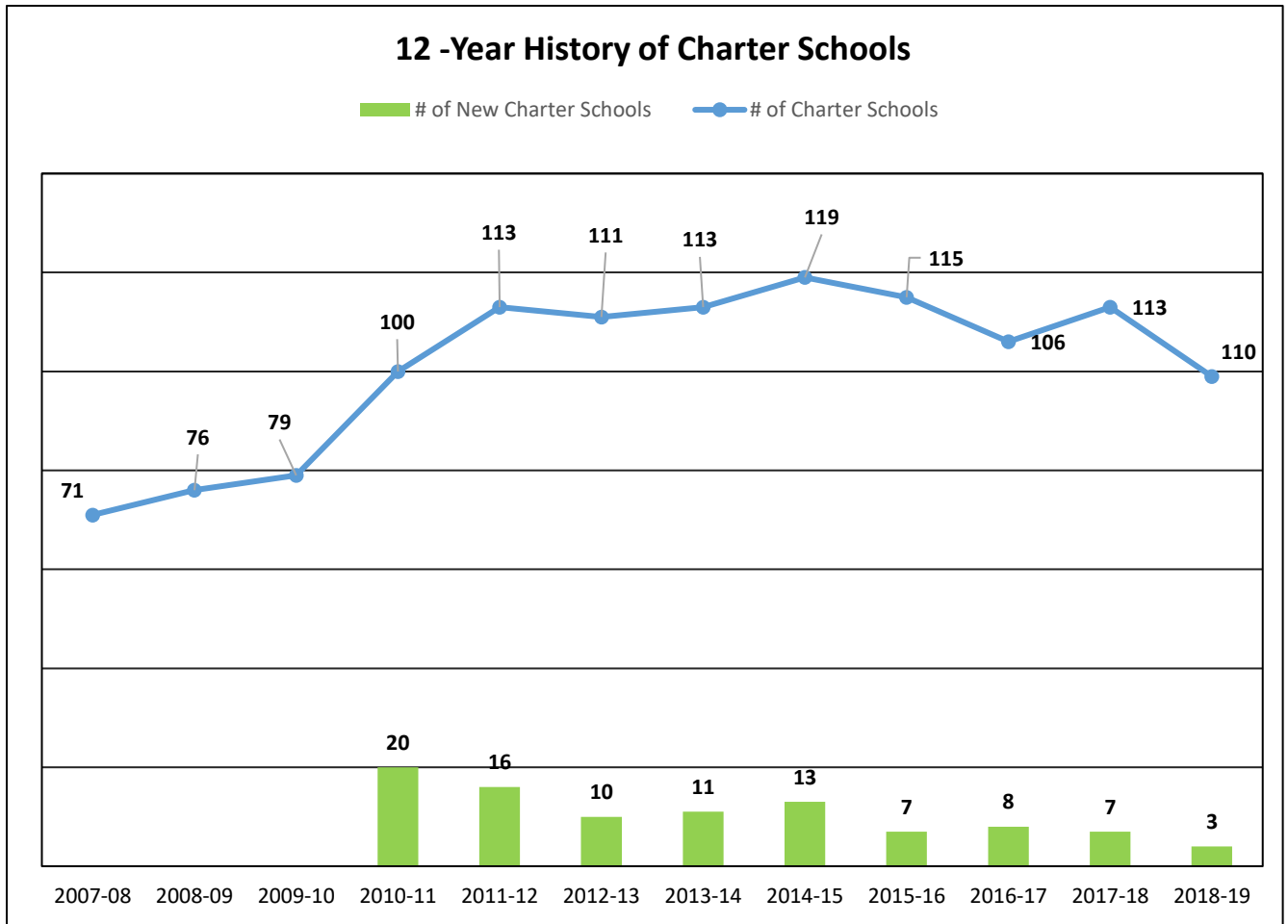

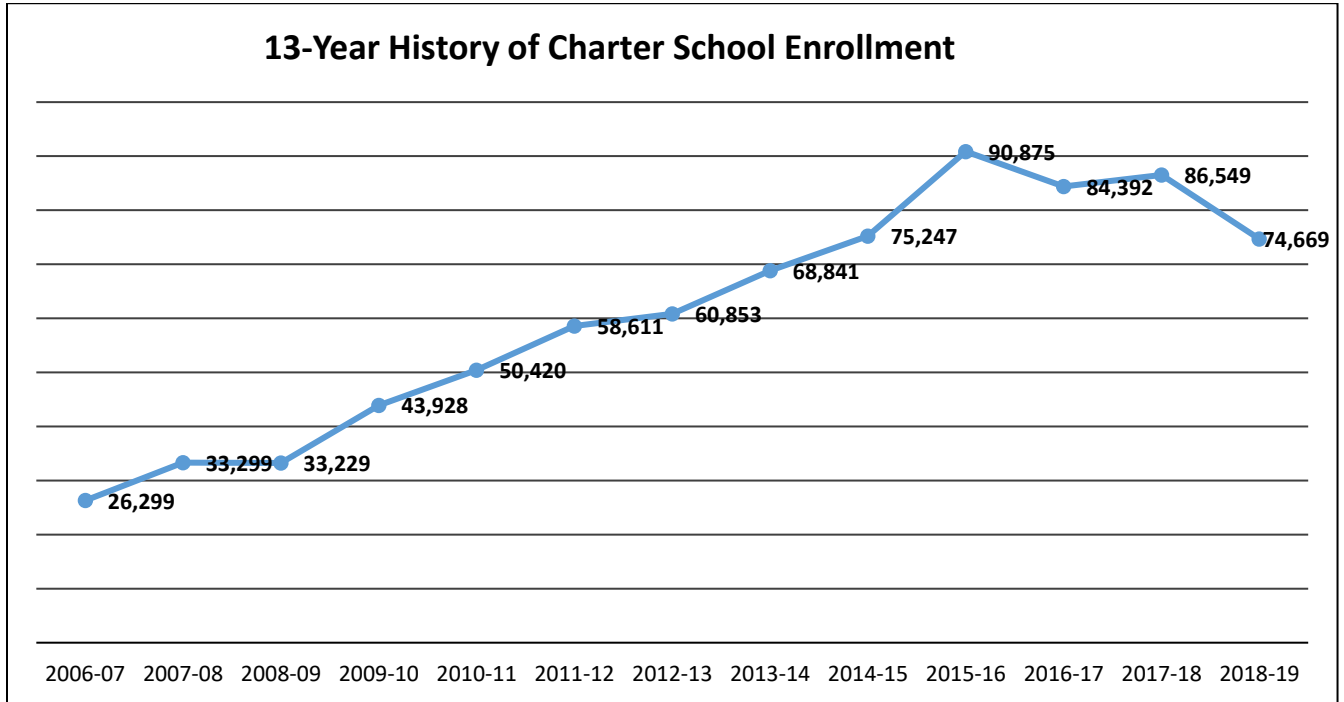

Historical Growth of Charter School Enrollment in Georgia

With the closure of charter school three schools, the transfer of 3 other schools to their home districts, one school eliminating grades K-5, and a significant fall-off of enrollment at Georgia Cyber Academy, there was a decrease of 11,860 students in charter schools this year.



Demographics of Charter Schools Compared to the State of Georgia

The racial and ethnic composition of Georgia charter schools is different than of the state. While all charter schools serve almost the same percent of White students as statewide (38.5% to 38.9%), all charter schools serve more Black students (46.5% to 36.4%) and fewer Hispanic students (9.0% to 16.3%) than the state.

Locally-approved Start-Up Charter Schools serve a significantly lower percent of White (28.4% to 38.9%) and Hispanic (7.4% to 16.3%) students and a significantly higher percent of Black students (60.2% to 36.4%) than statewide. State Charter Schools serve a significantly higher percent of White students (46.1% to 38.9%) and Black students (39.9% to 36.4%) and a significantly lower percent of Hispanic (8.4% to 16.3%) and Asian (1.3% to 4.3%) students than the state. Conversion Charter Schools serve a significantly higher percent of Asian students (11.5% to 4.3%) and a lower percent of Black students (26.9% to 36.4%) than statewide.

Support Services for Charter Schools Compared to the State of Georgia

The percentage of Special Education, English Language Learners (ELL), and Free and Reduced Lunch (FRL) eligibility students at different types of Georgia charter schools are different than that of the state, even though the overall percentages are similar for Special Education (12.1% for all charter schools to 12.4% statewide) and ELL (7% for all charter schools to 8% statewide).

Conversion Charter Schools serve a lower percent of Special Education students (10.4% to 12.4%), ELL students (6.5% to 8.0%), and FRL students (54.2% to 60.1%) than statewide. Locally-approved Start-Up Charter Schools serve a significantly lower percent of Special Education students (8.8% to 12.4%) and ELL students (4.2% to 8.0%) than statewide. State Charter Schools serve a significantly lower percent of Special Education students (9.9% to 12.4%), ELL students (2.6% to 8.0%), and FRL students (47.8% to 60.1%) than the state.

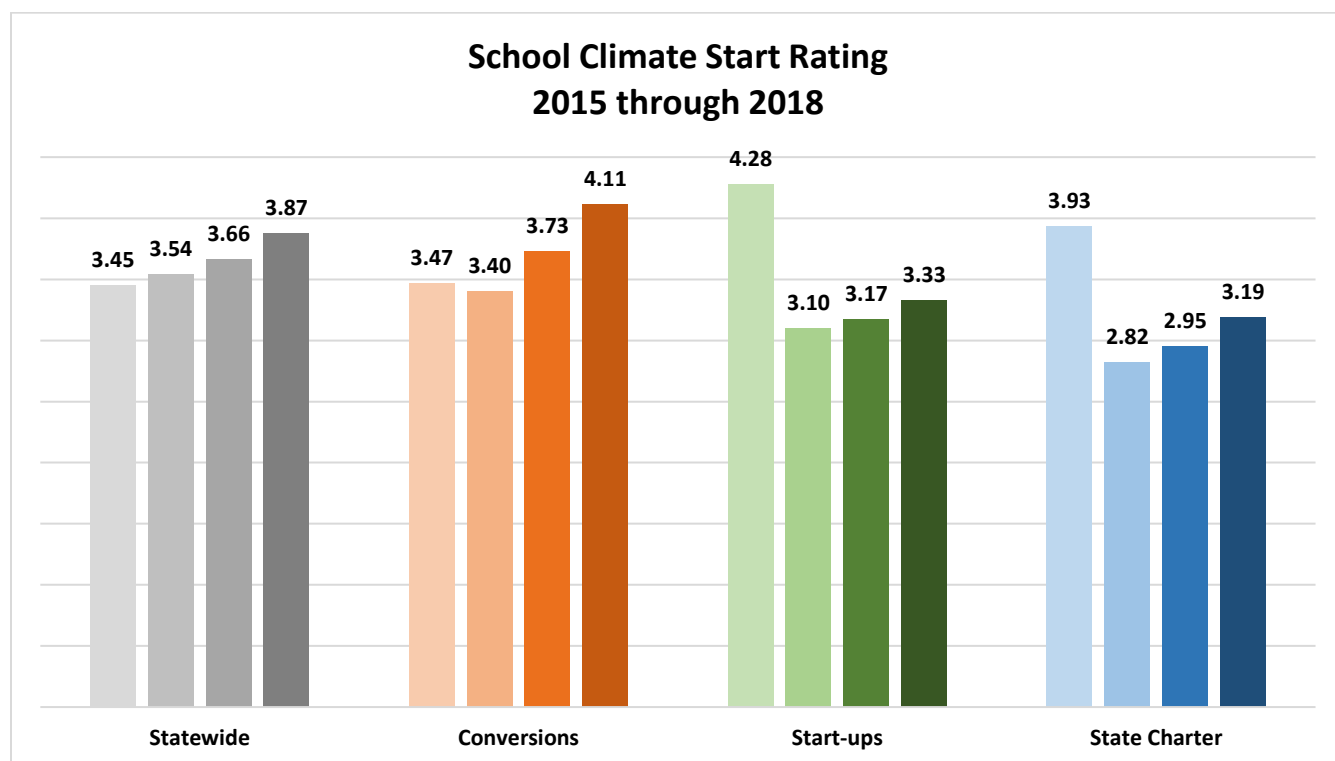

School Climate Star Rating

The National School Climate Center defines school climate as “the quality and character of school life” that is based on the “patterns of students’, parents’, and school personnel’s experiences of school life.”¹ School climate can be influenced by the norms, goals, values, interpersonal relationships, instructional practices, and organizational structures within a school. Research has found that schools with positive school climates tend to have better test scores and graduation rates; in contrast, schools with negative school climates as a result of unsafe or hostile environments tend to have lower academic performance.²

A sustainable, positive school climate supports people feeling socially, emotionally, and physically safe. In a positive school climate people are engaged and respected. By contrast, disruptive and aggressive behavior such as threats, bullying, teasing, and harassment creates a hostile school environment that interferes with academic performance. A hostile school environment fosters increased absenteeism and truancy because students feel unsafe at school. If a child is not physically and mentally in attendance, learning cannot take place.

Georgia is the first state in the nation to include school climate as an early indicator in its academic accountability system, the College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI). The School Climate Star Rating is a diagnostic tool to determine if a school is on the right path to school improvement. Up to five stars can be awarded.

Charter School Accountability

This section provides information on Charter School Academic Performance, including summary information and detail on each charter school in the state. Information is sorted by the authorizer that approved the charter contract, including either the local district and State Board of Education, or the State Charter Schools Commission.

Given the two major changes in CCRPI since it was first introduced, CCRPI for the three years 2012-2014 are comparable to each other, and CCRPI for the three years 2015-2017 are also comparable to each other. The new redesigned CCRPI for 2018 – as presented in the US Department of Education-approved Georgia State Plan required by the reauthorization of ESSA – begins a new period of comparability. While the graphs and tables below show a time series of CCRPI from 2012 through 2018, the different comparability periods are typically separated by blank column in charts and by a vertical line in graphs.

An overview of CCRPI for all charter schools over time, including the number of charter and other schools in the system, enrollment numbers, and a list of charter schools is presented first. Second is demographic information about each charter school. Third is information on support services (Special Education, English Language Learner, and Free and Reduced Lunch percentages). Last is academic accountability data, including the following measures.

Beating the Odds (BTO) – BTO is a complement to CCRPI as an accountability measure in performance contracts between locally-approved charter schools, their districts, and the State Board of Education; it is also used as a “second look” measure in State Charter Schools Commission charter contracts. Schools that “Beat the Odds” may have low CCRPI scores and/or gaps in performance – while schools with high CCRPI scores sometimes do not “Beat the Odds” if they are performing lower than other schools with similar characteristics. In addition to technical documentation, GOSA recently published a [two-page summary](#) of the newly-revised BTO model to help school- and district-level staff better understand it. College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) - CCRPI is a comprehensive school improvement, accountability, and communication platform for all educational stakeholders that was designed to promote college and career readiness for all Georgia public school students. CCRPI is included as performance measure in both local and state charter school charter contracts. Schools are challenged to increase their CCRPI score each year. This section provides an updated look at the academic standing of each charter school, including the following performance measures.

Content Mastery (Sorted by Grade Band and Score) - This CCRPI component measures whether students are achieving at the level necessary to be prepared for the next grade, college, or career. It is comprised of achievement scores in English language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies and is a 100-point scale, based on a weighted score of the four levels of achievement. 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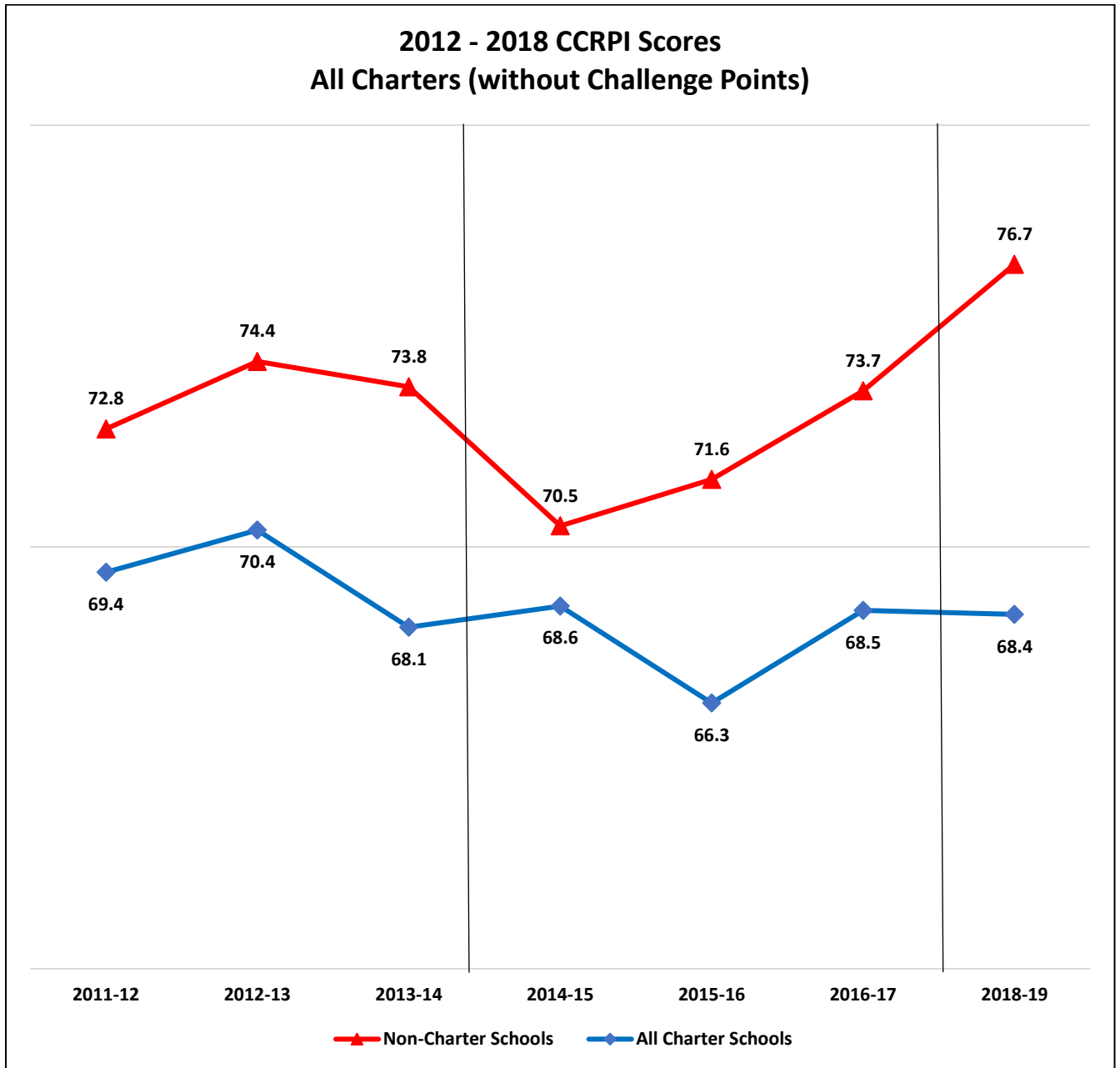
2012-2014 Comparable CCRPI Score – Line graph comparing all charter schools in the district against the total district CCRPI score (minus challenge points) as well as the state.

2015-2017 Comparable CCRPI Score – Line graph comparing all charter schools in the district against the total district CCRPI score (minus challenge points) as well as the state.

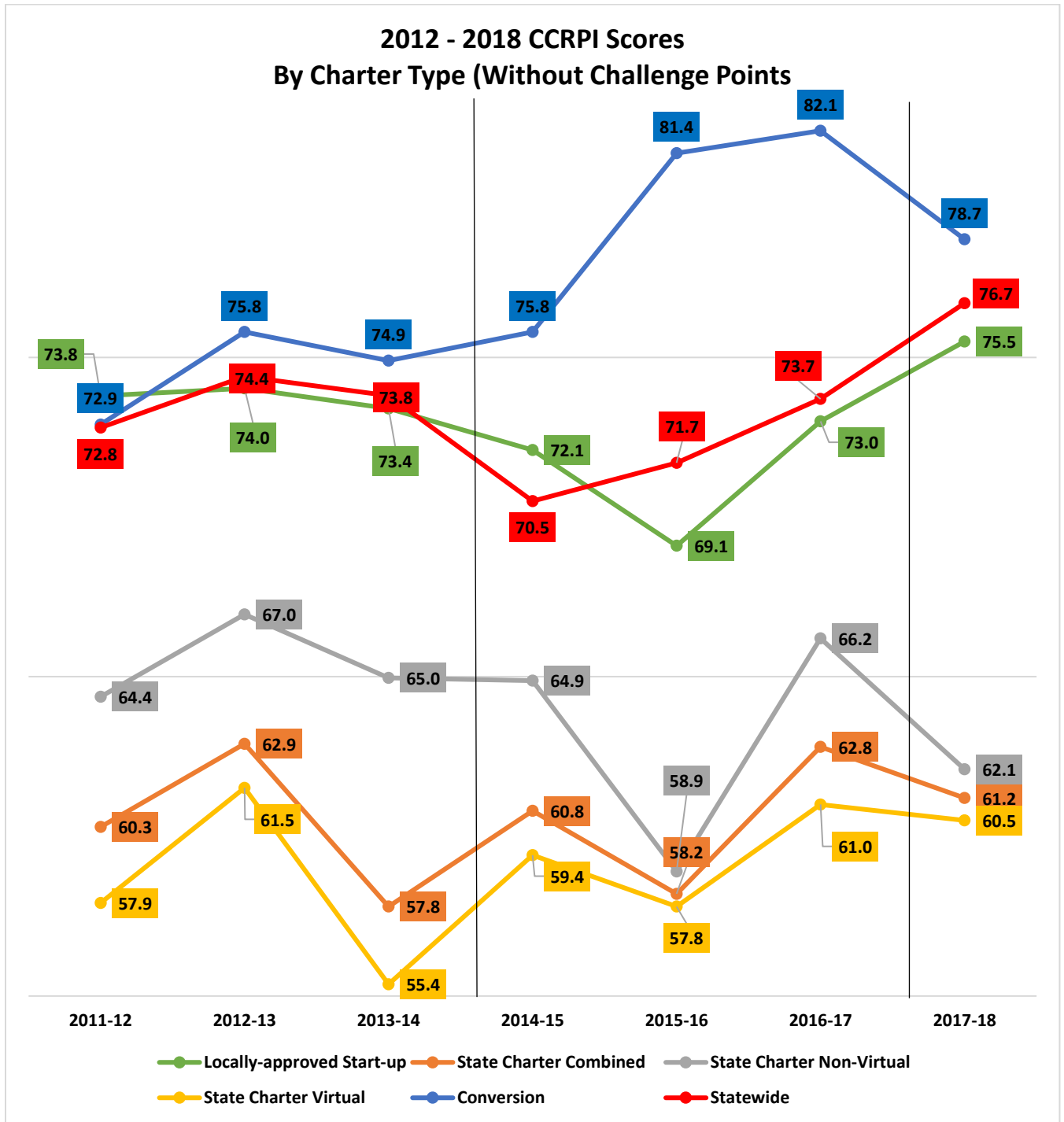
2018 Comparable CCRPI Score – Line graph comparing all charter schools in the district against the total district CCRPI score (minus challenge points) as well as the state.

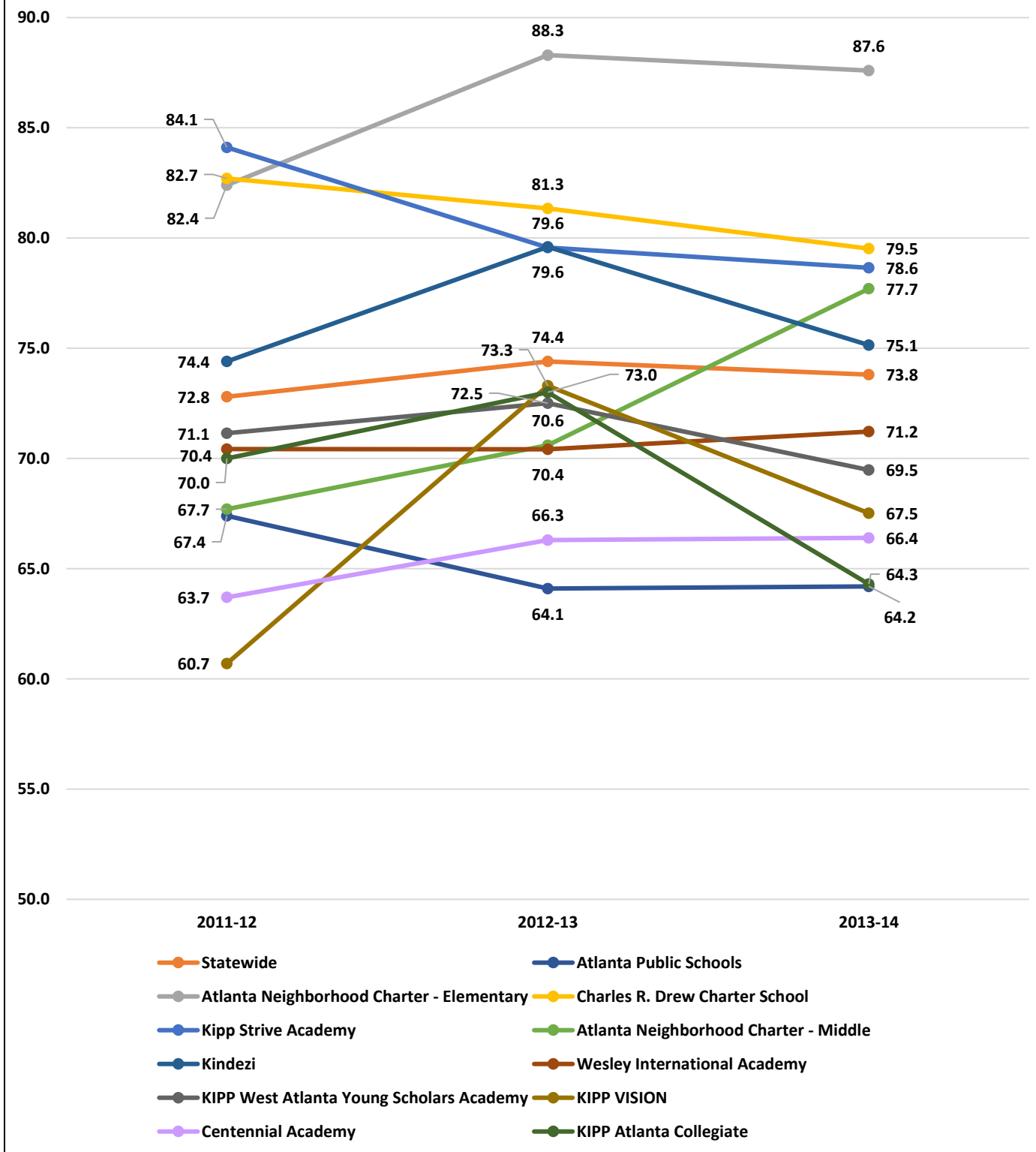

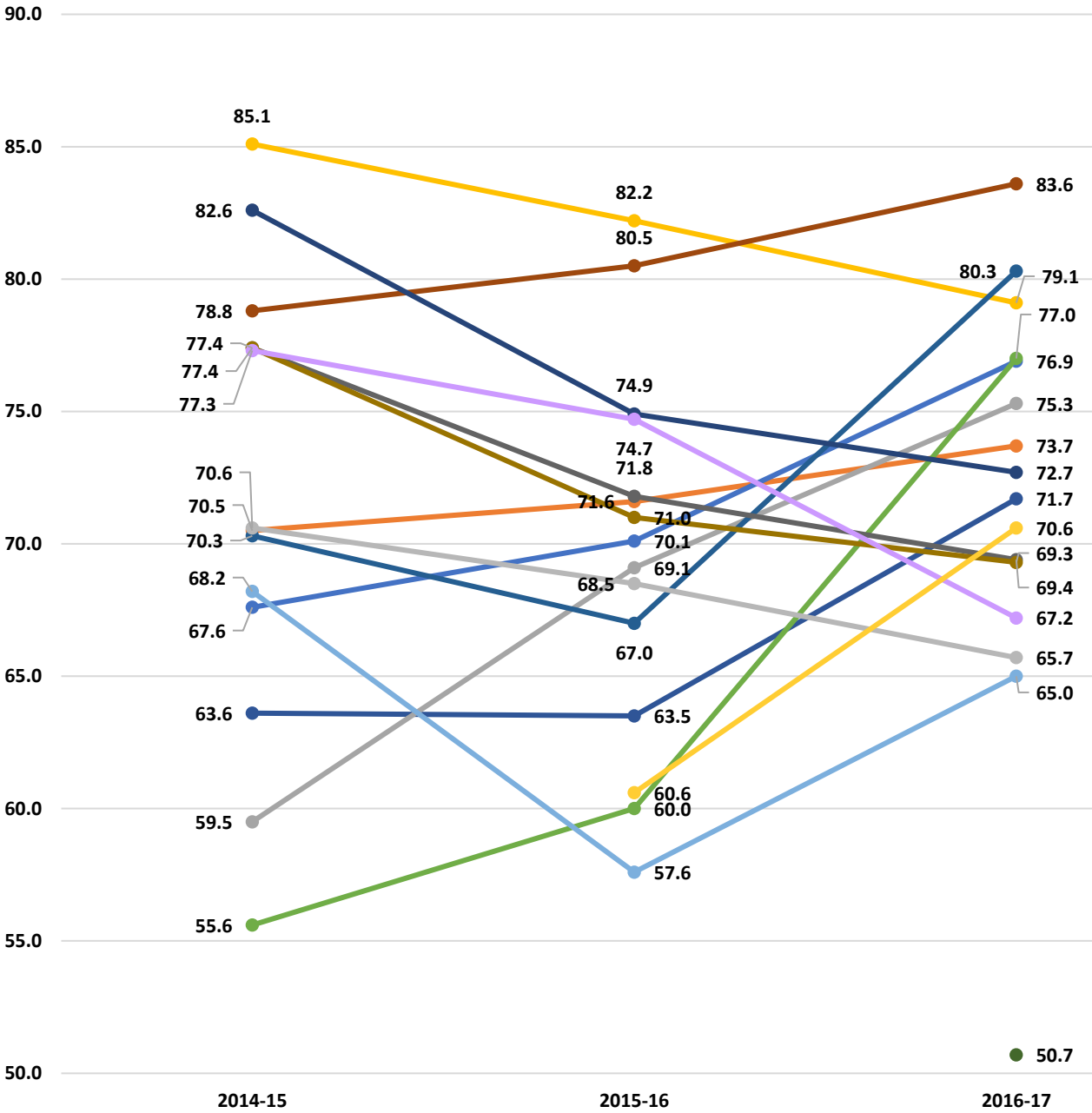

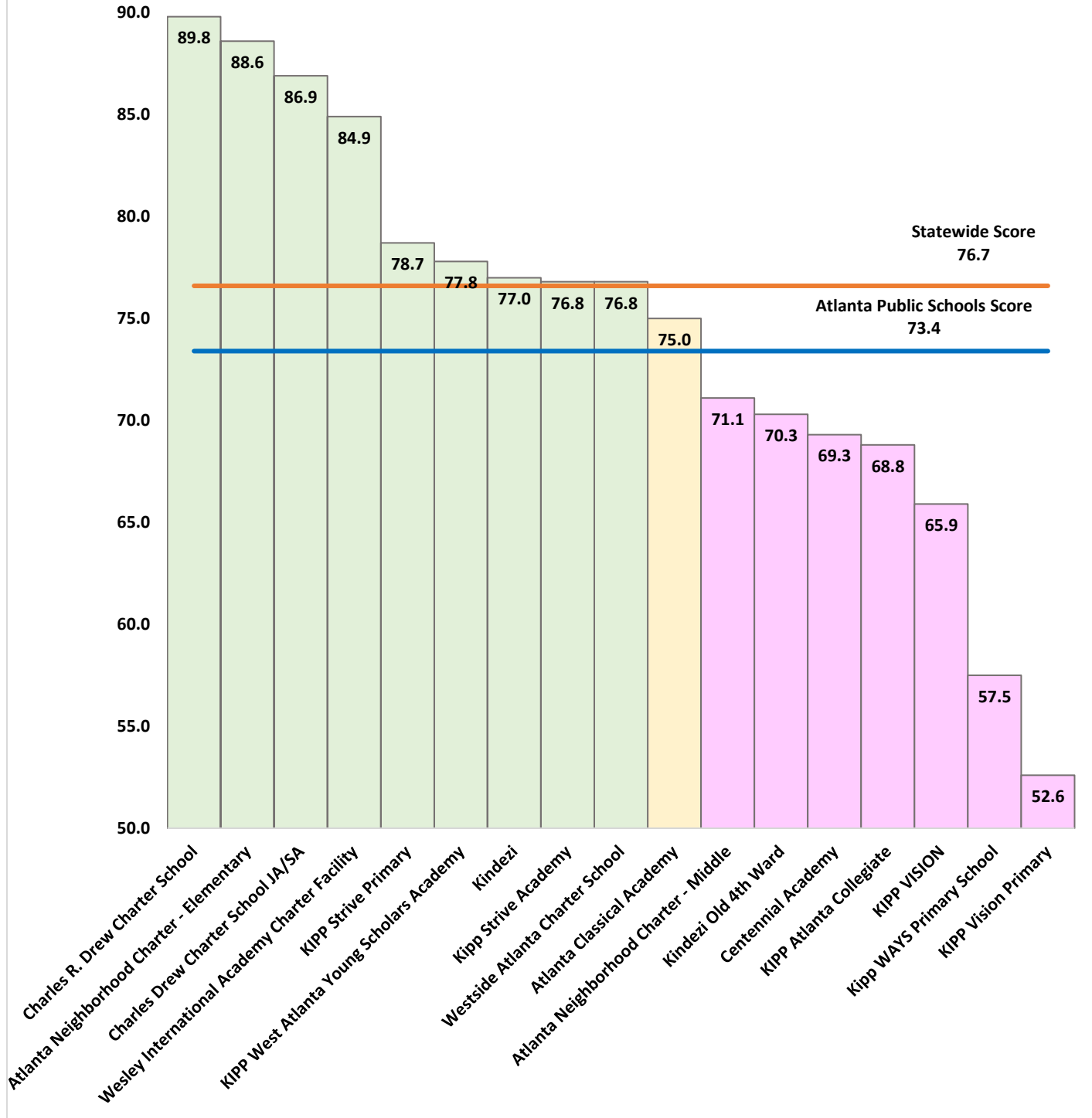
2012-2014 CCRPI Charter Schools in Atlanta Public Schools

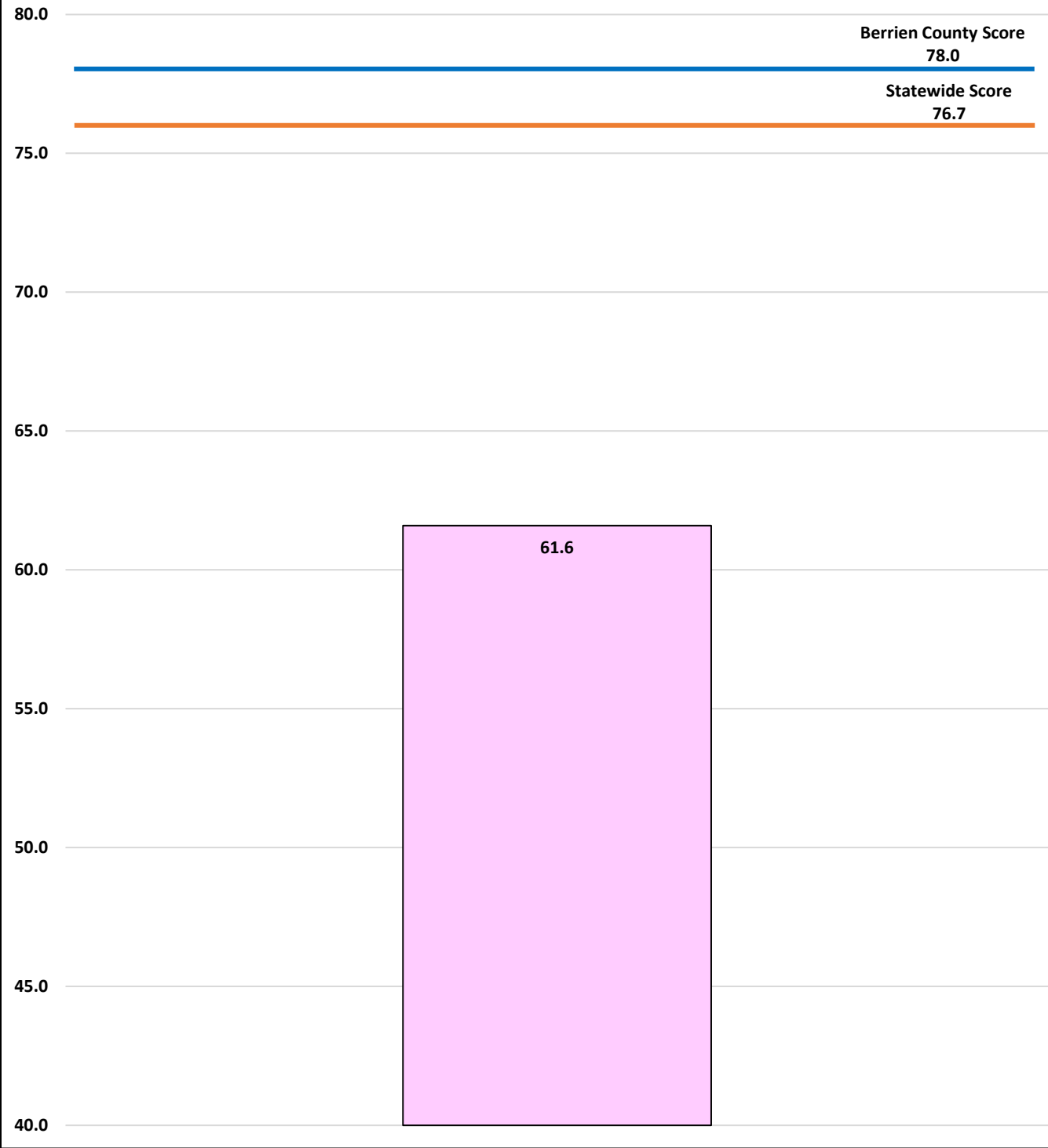

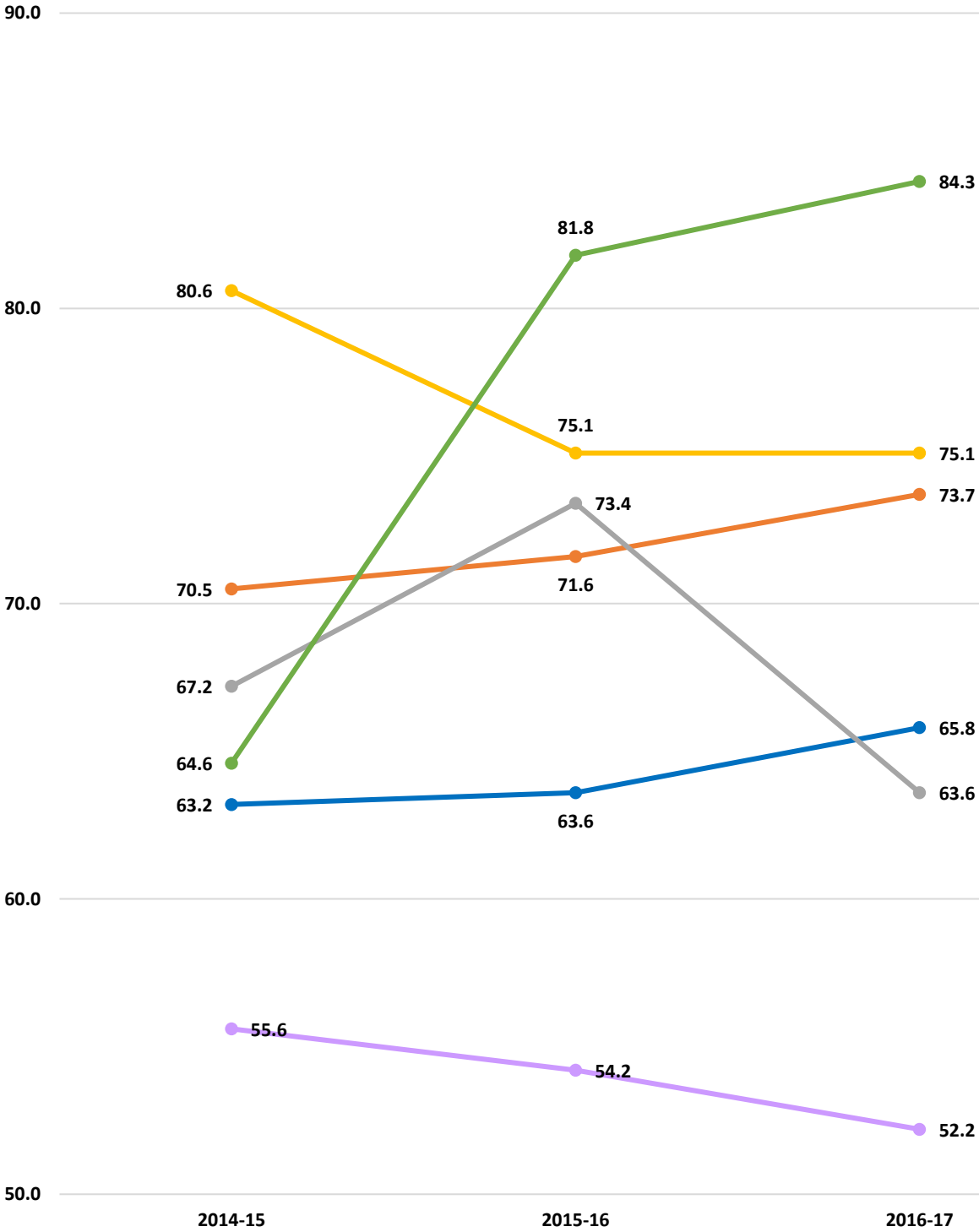

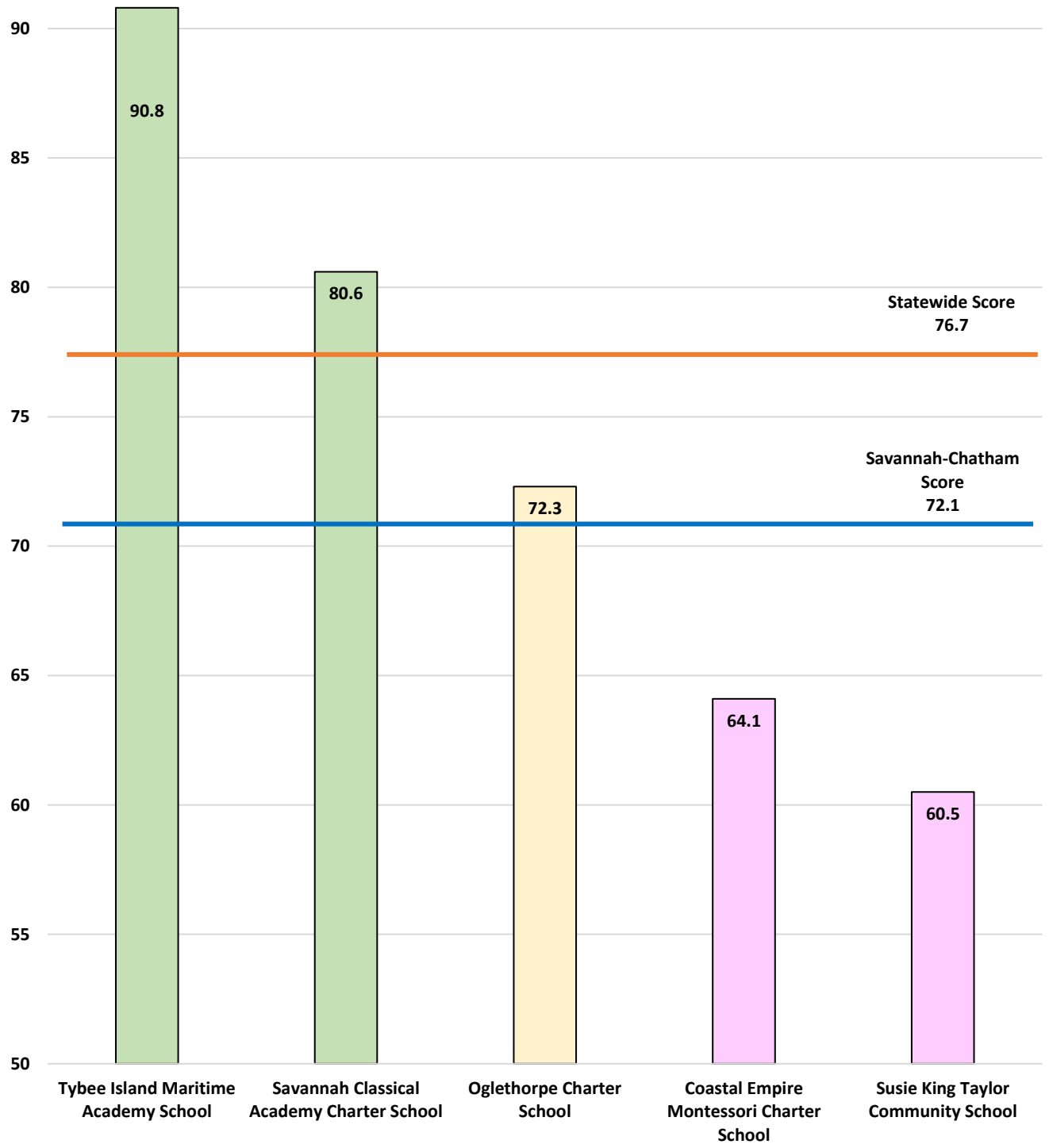

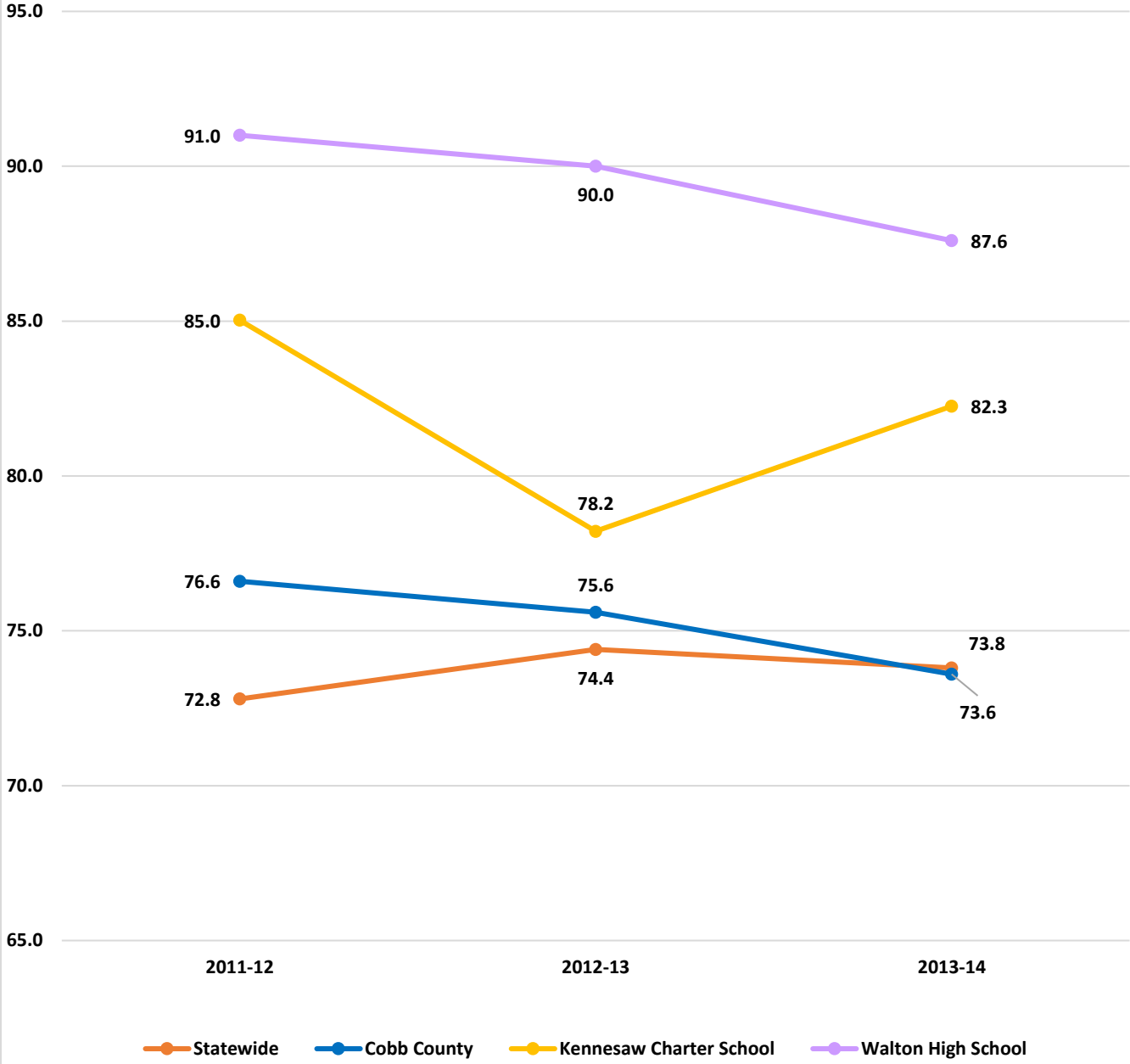

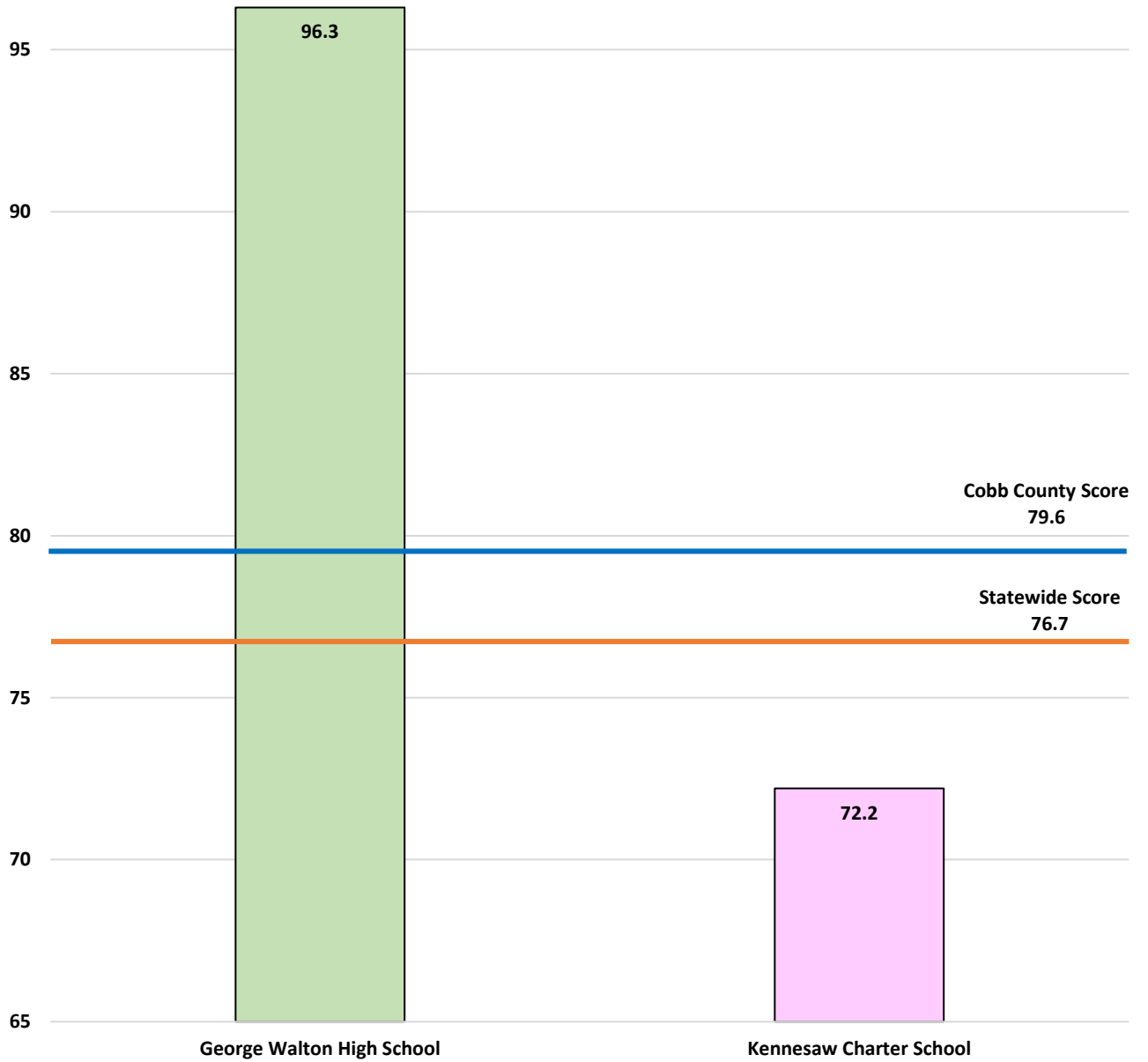
2012-2014 CCRPI Charter Schools in Cobb County

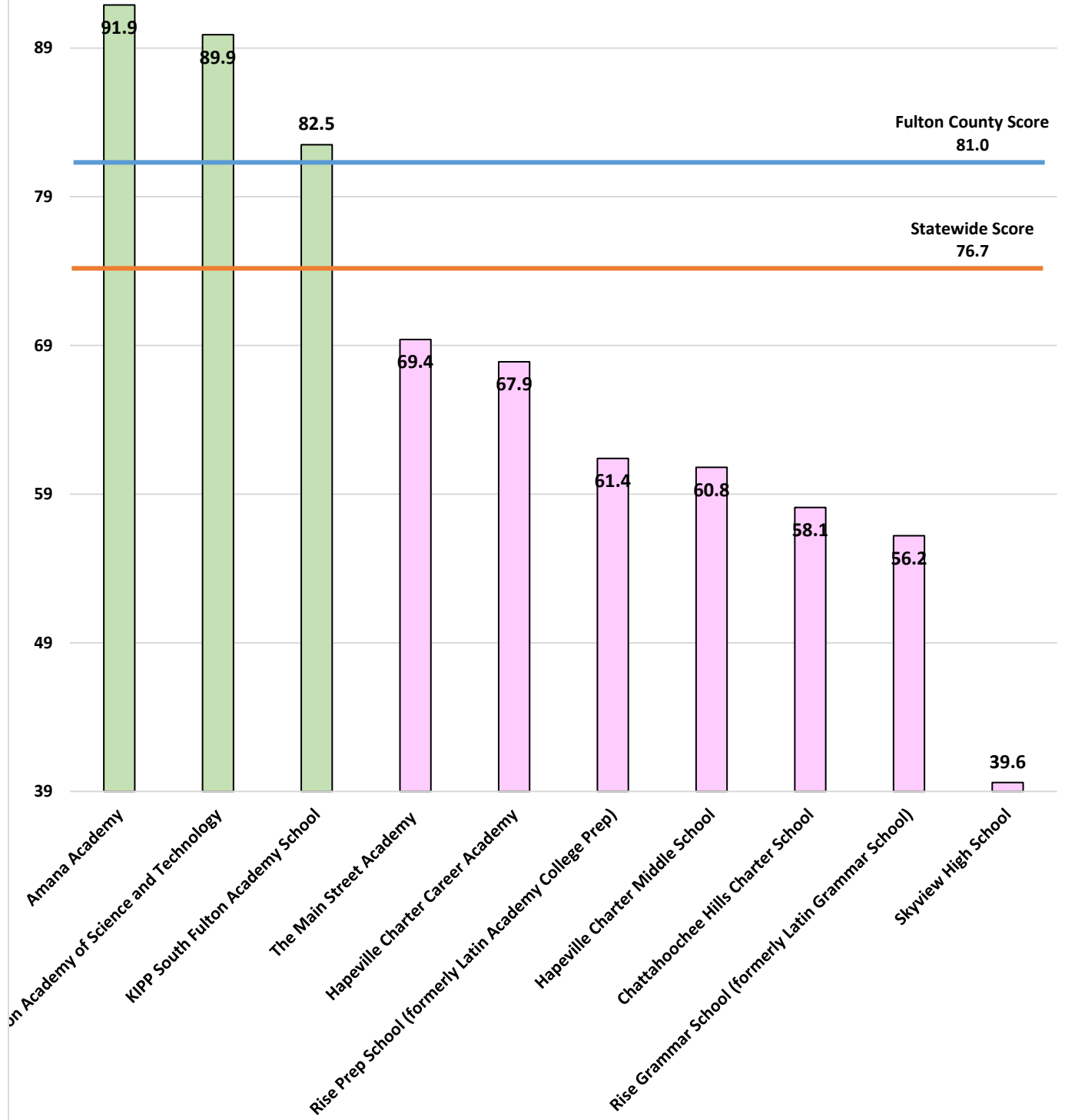

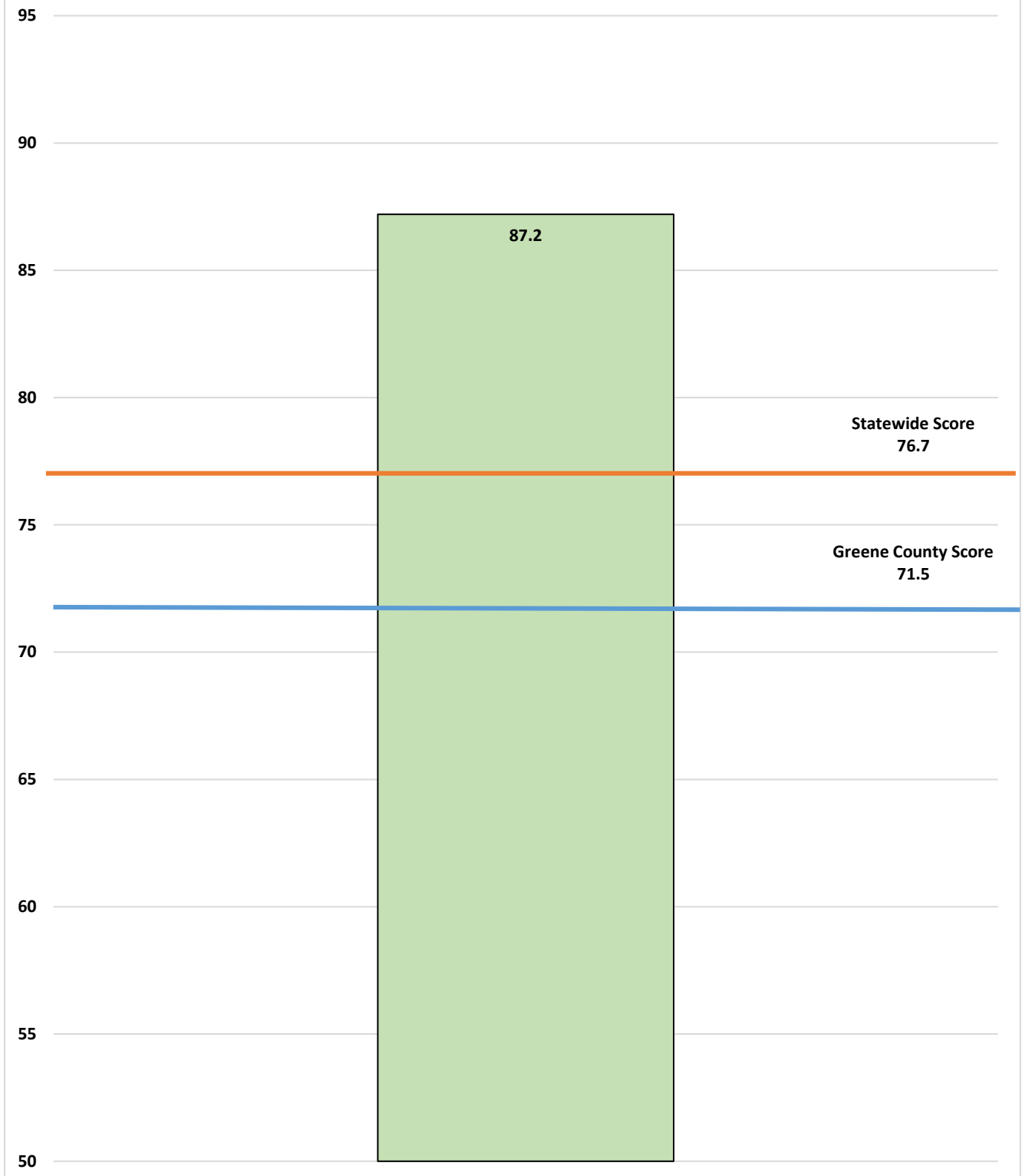

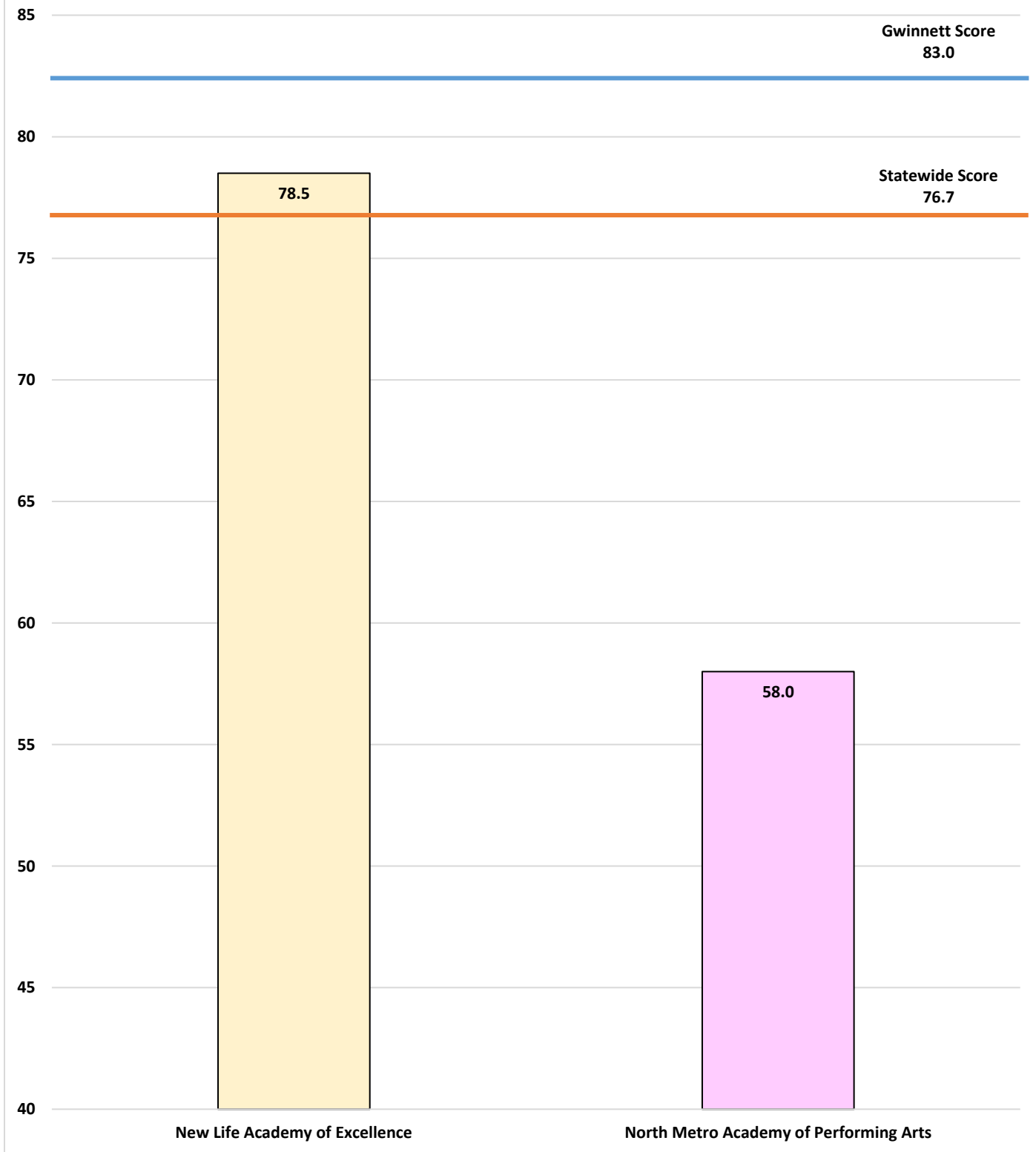

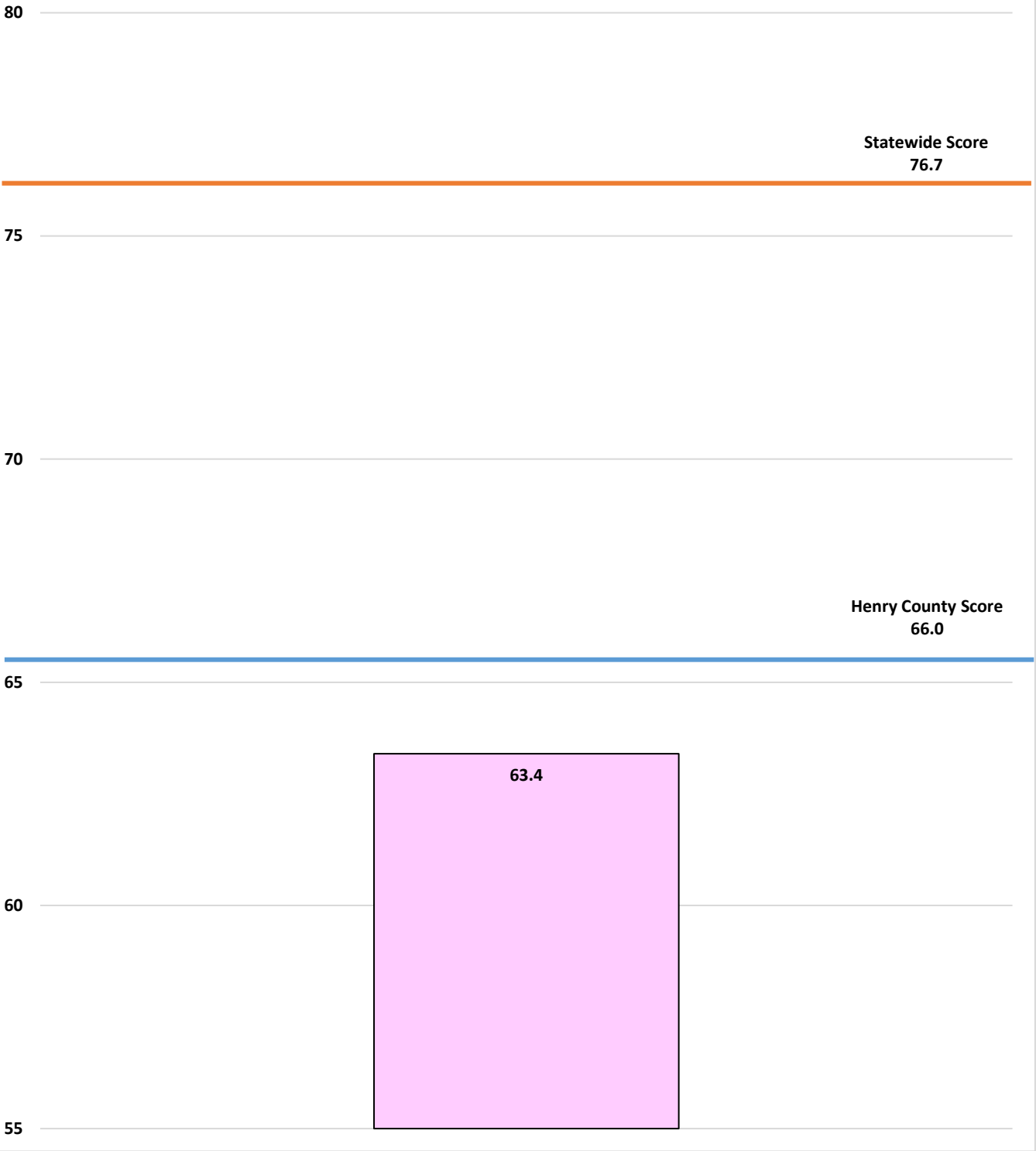

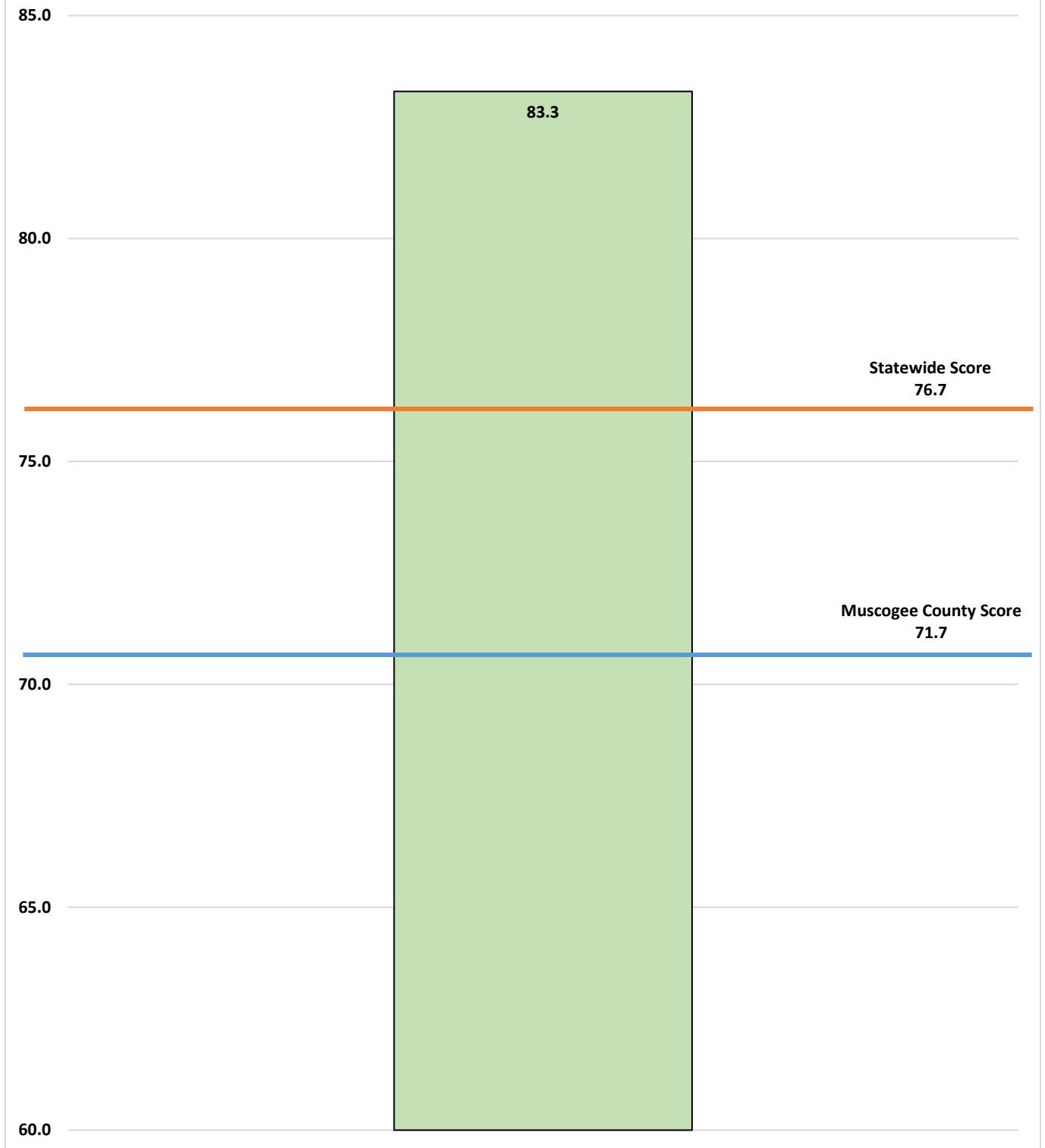
