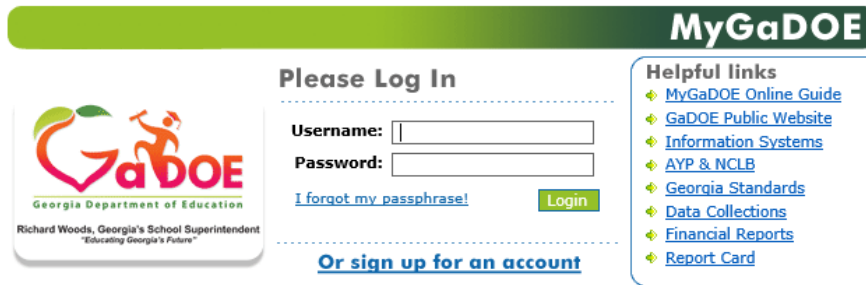

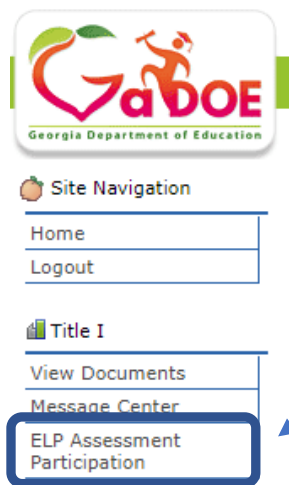

Accessing the ELP Assessment Participation Application

1. Log in to the [MyGaDOE portal system](#).

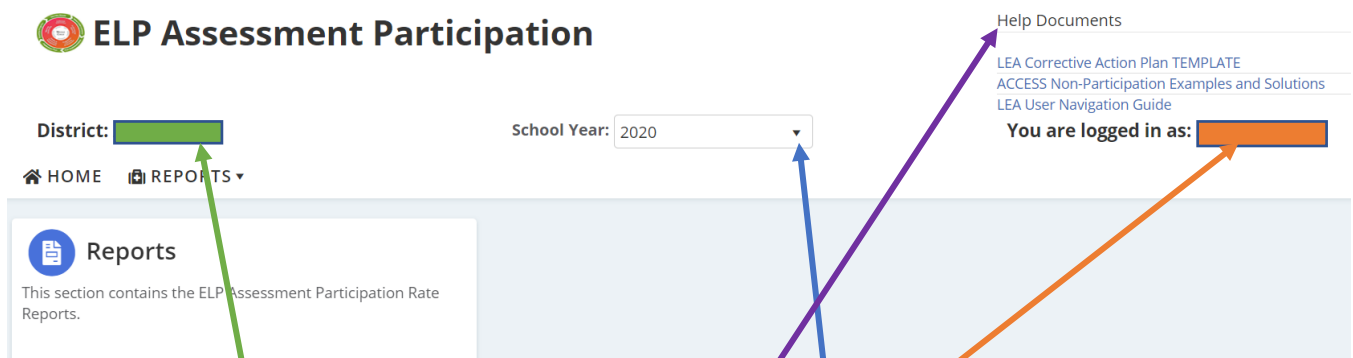


2. From the Home page menu on the left, select **ELP Assessment Participation**.



Each user's Home Page menu varies depending on the user's permissions. The menu may look different from this screenshot, although, the link to open the ELP Assessment Participation application will look like this.

3. This is the ELP Assessment Participation (ELPAP) landing or **HOME** page.



Your **District Name** will display in the top left corner; your **User Role** will display in the top right corner. You will have the option to change the **School Year** using this drop-down menu. Currently there are three (3) **Help Documents**.

4. Click on **Reports**.

The **ELP Assessment Participation Rate** will be reported each year. The LEA's rates will be displayed for **three years** starting with the 2020 ELP Assessment. A comparison between the LEA (District) and the State is provided.

6. Click on the **ELP Assessment Participation Rate** to open the student level Excel spreadsheet file with basic demographic information, ACCESS Overall Composite Scale Scores, and LEA-reported non-participation reasons. **Reminder:** System Testing Coordinators have previously reported students' non-participation reasons in the *Assessment & Accountability Non-Participation* portal application.

Rate Denominator: The total number (No.) of EL students reported in Student Record who were enrolled during the ACCESS/Alternate ACCESS testing window, excluding medical emergencies.

Rate Numerator: The total number (No.) of EL students who participated in the ACCESS/Alternate ACCESS assessment and have an overall Composite Scale Score.

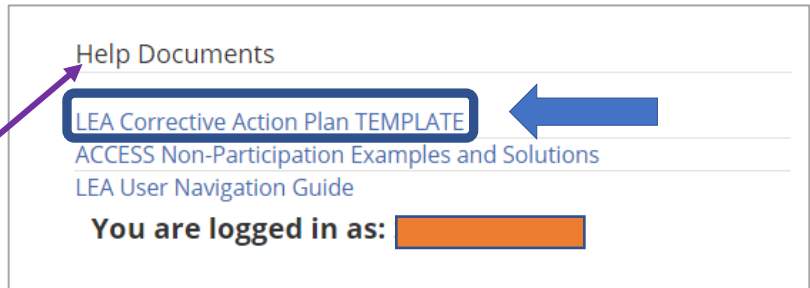
2021 ACCESS/Alternate ACCESS Assessment Participation Rate Only:
