- Answers the questions:
  - Are students achieving at college and career ready levels?
  - Are students engaged in opportunities to prepare them for college and careers?
  - Are students graduating high school or are they on track to graduate high school?
- Measures:
  - **Content Mastery** – Student performance on state assessments
  - **Post Readiness** – Student performance on or participation in other measures of college and career readiness
  - **Graduation Rate** – High school cohort graduation rate or predictor for high school graduation

# Content Mastery Proficiency Rate Formula



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$$\text{Rate} = \frac{0.5 (\text{DEV Student Count}) + 1.0 (\text{PRO Student Count} + \text{ADV Student Count}) + 1.5 (\text{DIS Student Count})}{\text{Total Count of FAY Students with Test Scores}}$$

- Utilizes a weighted average
- Acknowledges the meanings of the new Georgia Milestones achievement levels
  - **Developing** Learners have demonstrated partial proficiency
  - **Proficient** Learners have demonstrated proficiency
  - **Distinguished** Learners have demonstrated advance proficiency
- Provides incentive to and acknowledges the work schools are doing to move all students to the next level
- Beginning Learners earn 0 points, Developing Learners earn 0.5 point, Proficient Learners earn 1 point, Distinguished Learners earn 1.5 points



## Content Mastery Calculation Example

- 200 students at Main Street HS took the Biology EOC.
- 190 of those students are FAY Participants.
  - ✓ 30 students scored at Beginning Learner. ( $30 \times 0 = 0$ )
  - ✓ 60 students scored at Developing Learner. ( $60 \times .5 = 30$ )
  - ✓ 70 students scored at Proficient Learner. ( $70 \times 1 = 70$ )
  - ✓ 30 students scored at Distinguished Learner. ( $30 \times 1.5 = 45$ )

$$0 + 30 + 70 + 45 \div 190 = .7631578 = 76.316$$








- Performance Flags are triggered by **Performance Targets**.
- Performance Targets have been re-established for Georgia Milestones and graduation rates through 2021. \*
- The Georgia Milestones targets are based on a weighted average
  - Beginning Learners earn 0.0 points
  - Developing Learners earn 0.5 points
  - Proficient Learners earn 1.0 point
  - Distinguished Learners earn 1.5 points

# Setting Performance Targets

$$\text{Annual Growth} = \frac{(100 - \text{Weighted Proficiency Rate}) \times .50}{6}$$

## Example of one subgroup in one content area

If the weighted Proficiency Rate is 40%, then the weighted Non-Proficiency rate is 60%. The state of GA must cut that 60% in half over 6 years.

$$60/2 = 30\%$$

To decrease the weighted Non-Proficiency rate 30% over 6 years would be to decrease  $30/6$  or 5% per year. This is the same as increasing the weighted Proficiency Rate by 5% each year.

## Targets for weighted Proficiency Rate

Baseline: 40%

Year 1:  $40\% + 5\% = 45\%$

Year 2:  $45\% + 5\% = 50\%$

Year 3:  $50\% + 5\% = 55\%$

Year 4:  $55\% + 5\% = 60\%$

Year 5:  $60\% + 5\% = 65\%$

Year 6:  $65\% + 5\% = 70\%$

# ED/EL/SWD Performance

1. Calculate the percent of test scores for ED/EL/SWD students for each school.
  - Denominator = the number of test scores for FAY Students
  - Numerator = the number of test scores for FAY Students who are coded as ED/EL/SWD (non-duplicated count)

A school has 1000 test scores for FAY Students. 600 are coded as ED/EL/SWD.

The percent of test scores for ED/EL/SWD students in the school is  $600/1000 = 60\%$ .

2. Calculate the maximum number of points, out of 10, that a school can earn based on the performance targets for ED/EL/SWD students.
  - Multiply the percent of ED/EL/SWD test scores for FAY Students by 10

$$60\% \times 10 = .60 \times 10 = 6$$

6 is the maximum number of points the example school can earn based on the performance targets for ED/EL/SWD students

3. Calculate the percent of ED/EL/SWD subgroups meeting the subgroup level performance target for each subject assessment and graduation rate (for high schools only). This calculation utilizes the flags.

$$\frac{\text{\# ED/EL/SWD subgroups meeting the subgroup performance target}}{\text{\# ED/EL/SWD subgroups}} \times 100 = \% \text{ meeting}$$

4. Calculate the points earned
  - Percent meeting subgroup performance target  $\times$  maximum points = points earned toward overall score

$$6 / 12 \text{ Flags} = .5 \times 6 = 3 \text{ points}$$
