SUBJECT: 2023-2024 Assessment Training Schedule

The Office of Assessment and Accountability hosts a series of virtual trainings for System Test Coordinators (STCs) over the course of the 2023-2024 school year. STCs are required to participate in all designated trainings. All training sessions are posted to the <u>Georgia Assessment and Training Calendar</u> and announcements of those sessions are found in the monthly Assessment Update newsletters posted on the <u>For System Test Coordinators</u> link.

STCs, School Test Coordinators, Test Examiners, and Proctors <u>are required</u> to attend the mandatory trainings noted in the tables below. Attendance will be recorded and collected for all sessions. It is strongly recommended that Technology Directors participate in the *Fall and Spring Technology Directors Training*. Special Education Directors and Title III/ESOL Coordinators should participate in the *State Assessment Training for System Test Coordinators – Parts 1 and 2*, the *Test Coordinator Training Course*, the *Accessibility and Accommodations for State Assessments Training Course*, *Georgia Milestones Test Examiner Training Course*, and *GAA 2.0 Test Examiner Training Course* to ensure all personnel have a strong understanding of assessment purposes, policies, and protocols.

Note: the WIDA ACCESS and WIDA Alternate ACCESS virtual trainings will take place through the WIDA 2023-2024 training schedule posted at <a href="https://wida.wisc.edu/">https://wida.wisc.edu/</a>. These WIDA training sessions will be included and announced to STCs through the monthly Assessment Updates and are also considered required.

Asynchronous courses provided through Georgia Learns must be completed annually by STCs, SchTCs, Test Examiners, and Proctors. Staff will receive a completion badge and certificate once they have completed the course successfully. STCs and SchTCs are responsible for collecting documentation of all Georgia Learns course completion certificates from staff and educators prior to any test administration windows and beginning any test sessions.

STCs and SchTCs must document attendance at all local training sessions and include agendas and supporting presentations and/or handouts with specific guidance and policy related to test security and assessment administration protocols. Training must include a review of Examiner's Manuals and define and clarify test security breaches and incidents of irregularities and invalidations. Local training must clearly articulate the process and procedure for reporting irregularities for review by the STC and subsequent reporting to the Office of Assessment and Accountability for review. Test Security Information for School Test Coordinators/Examiners/Proctors and Assessment Security Compliance Forms may be used to provide documentation of personnel attestation of understanding test security obligations (Student Assessment Handbook, Appendix B).
