

Georgia Student Assessment Handbook Errata Sheet

This errata sheet provides revisions to eligibility requirements for Georgia Milestones End of Course (EOC) Retest Administrations beginning with the Spring 2016 EOC Mid-Month Administration.

Eligibility for retests

The following students are eligible to participate in EOC retest administrations:

- Students who received a **Grade Conversion Score below 70** beginning with test results from the Fall 2015 Mid-Month administration (where 20% applied), the Winter 2015 EOC administration, and beyond.
- ~~Students who passed the course, but who did not reach the *Developing Learner* Achievement Level or above on the associated EOC beginning with the Fall 2015 Mid-Month (where 20% applied) and/or Winter 2015 EOC administration.~~
- ~~Students who did not pass the course and who also did not reach the *Developing Learner* Achievement Level or above on the associated EOC beginning with the Fall 2015 Mid-Month (where 20% applied) and/or Winter 2015 EOC administration.~~

Retests are not provided for EOCs that were taken prior to the Fall 2015 Mid-Month administration given that the final exam role of the EOC was waived during the 2014-2015 school year. Consideration should be given to whether a retest would be in a student's best interest. **Students are not required to participate in retest administrations.** Students who "passed" (Grade Conversion Score of 70 or above) the EOC are not eligible to retest, regardless of whether they passed the course or not. **The decision about the use of EOC retest results in amending an original course grade is a local one.**

Eligible students may participate in a retest administration only once for the semester/year in which the student was enrolled in the associated course. For example, a student who did not **obtain a Grade Conversion score of 70 or above** ~~reach the *Developing Learner* Achievement Level or above~~ on the Biology EOC in Winter 2015 is eligible to participate in any of the retest windows that follow the Winter 2015 administration within the 2015-2016 school year. The student is limited to one retest opportunity. **Systems/Schools should document their processes and attempts to notify students of their retest opportunity.**
