	Extensions	Web Apps	Add-ons
What are they?	Small helper tools to give you more features in Chrome	Larger stand-alone web programs	Extra tools for Docs, Sheets, and Forms
How do you install them for yourself?	Installed from the Chrome Web Store at chrome.google.com/webstore	Installed from the Chrome Web Store at chrome.google.com/webstore	Installed from the Add-ons menu in Docs, Sheets, and Forms
How can you install them for your users?	Can be pushed to users through "Chrome management" in the GAFE Admin Console	Can be pushed to users through "Chrome management" in the GAFE Admin Console	Can be pushed to users through "Marketplace Apps" in the GAFE Admin Console
Where do they go when installed?	Show up as small icons in top right corner of the Chrome browser	Show up as large icons on the Apps page in Chrome	Show up in the Add-ons menu in Docs, Sheets, and Forms
What devices can they be installed on?	PCs, Macs, and Chromebooks running the Chrome web browser	PCs, Macs, and Chromebooks running the Chrome web browser	PCs, Macs, and Chromebooks running any major browser
How do you run them?	Click the icon for the extension in top right corner of the Chrome browser	Click the icon for the web app icon on the Apps page in Chrome	Click the add-on in the Add-ons menu in Docs, Sheets, and Forms
Where can they be used when run?	Can typically run on any webpage in Chrome	Typically standalone applications that run in their own tab	Only run inside of Docs, Sheets, and Forms
Can they be disabled?	Can be temporarily disabled. Right click on extension icon, choose "Manage extensions" and uncheck "Enabled"	Can not be temporarily disabled. Only can be removed.	Can not be temporarily disabled. Only can be removed.
How can they be removed?	Right click on extension icon and choose "Remove from Chrome"	Right click on the web app icon and choose "Remove from Chrome"	Click "Add-ons" then "Manage Add-ons" then "Manage" then "Remove"
Do they use device resources?	Use memory and resources at all times Chrome is open	Only use memory and resources when web app is running	Only use memory and resources when add-on is running
Can you use them on multiple devices?	Automatically installed wherever you log into the Chrome web browser on any computer	Automatically installed wherever you log into the Chrome web browser on any computer	Automatically installed wherever you log into Google Drive on any computer
