We must create an early intervening plan to submit when we submit our *Student Success Imagine the Possibilities* plan.





• Our LEA's LRE data indicated that we did not meet the target for Indicator 5 on the SPP/APR.

Our district's placement data that provides information regarding how much time a student is receiving their instruction in the general education setting shows that we did not meet the state target for students placed in the general education class for  $\geq 80\%$  of the day.
