Georgia Virtual School (GAVS) is part of the Georgia Department of Education's Office of Technology Services. GAVS is fully accredited and operates in partnership with Georgia parents and schools to offer high school level courses across the state.

### Frequently Asked Questions

#### Will I be required to speak the language in my course?

Yes. Your teacher will schedule mandatory sessions through a program called Elluminate. These are often scheduled in the evening. You will be required to attend these sessions in order to demonstrate your speaking proficiency. These sessions do not take place every evening, but most classes require attendance at five sessions, with an additional five recorded submissions.

\*While Latin might not require a spoken component, Elluminate sessions are still required.

#### Which World Language Courses are currently offered through GAVS?

GAVS currently offers the following World Language Courses:

#### Am I guaranteed enrollment in these courses?

Unfortunately, enrollment in each course is limited and students are accepted on a first come, first served basis.

#### Are Georgia Virtual Schools course offerings right for me?

All students in the State of Georgia are eligible to register for GAVS courses. The State of Georgia is excited to provide this progressive option for students to study World Languages, and students who are most successful in GAVS World Language courses tend to have good time-management skills, and the ability to attend regular Elluminate classes. The speaking component is 20% of the overall class grade, so please be aware of the importance of the required speaking component of these courses.
