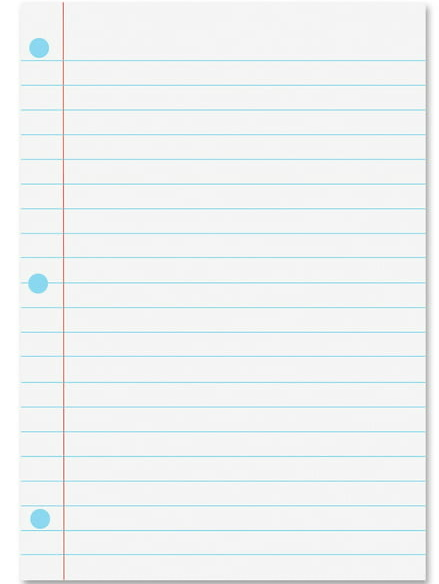
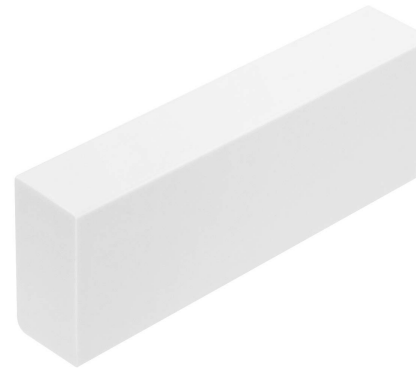

The Purpose of the 21st CCLC Program

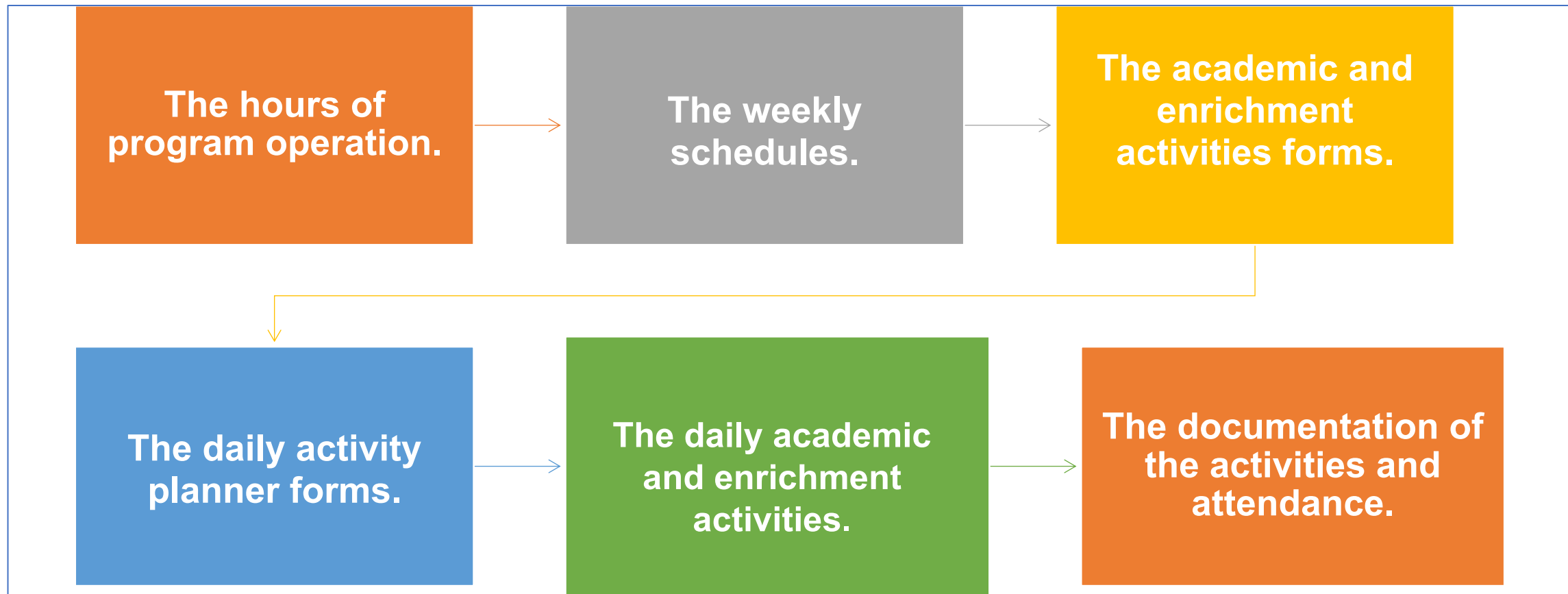
