Statewide Longitudinal Data System (SLDS)



High School Feedback Report

The High School Feedback (HSFB) report provides authorized users with valuable information about their high school graduates. The report provides detailed student level data about the number of high school graduates enrolled in a Technical College System of Georgia (TCSG), a University System of Georgia (USG) college or university, a U.S. college outside of Georgia, or a private college within Georgia (NSC). Note: NSC stands for National Student Clearinghouse. This category includes all graduates who attended a private Georgia college or a college outside of Georgia.


The HSFB Report allows Administrators to answer the following questions.

- What % of my high school graduates went to a public college in Georgia?
- What % of my high school graduates went to a private Georgia college, or attended college outside of Georgia?
- What did the students major in?
- Did the students require remediation in college?

Accessing the Report

The High School Feedback report button is located on the menu bar when you login to SLDS. The report contains the data of the students that previously graduated from high schools within the district.

The High School graduation year is based on signed off Student Record (SR) data. The HS Graduation year is only assigned if the student has a Student Record withdrawal code of G. If the student graduated after the SR deadline for the applicable year, then the graduation year in the HS Feedback report will not be updated until the next SR data collection period. The SR deadline occurs in late June.




High School Feedback Charts and Drill-through

The main High School Feedback dashboard contains four charts. The names of the charts are High School Graduates, % of HS Graduates that Attended TCSG or USG or NSC, College Attendance by High School, and College Remediation. Additional information about each of the charts is displayed below.


High School Graduates Chart


The High School Graduates chart displays the percentage of students that did not go to TCSG/USG/NSC and the percentage of students that went to TCSG/USG/NSC. Users may click on the title or on a section of the pie chart to view more detailed information. The drill through report displays the number of high school graduates going to TCSG, USG, and NSC. The report also contains the K-12 Subgroup Categories (ELL, ESOL, ED, SWD, Gifted, Remedial, and Migrant). All of the information in the drill through report can be displayed by high school, TCSG, USG, or NSC by selecting a value from the Document Map on the left side of the page. All of the hyperlinked values allow users to drill down to the list of students.



% of HS Graduates that Attended TCSG or USG or NSC

This report displays the percentage of enrollments by TCSG, USG, and NSC colleges and universities. Users may click on the title or on a section of the pie chart to view more detailed information. The drill through report displays the total number of students enrolled in TCSG, USG, or NSC by college/university. The report also contains the K-12 Subgroup Categories (ELL, ESOL, ED, SWD, Gifted, Remedial, and Migrant). Users can easily toggle between TCSG, USG, and NSC by making a selection on the document map.






College Attendance by High School

This report displays the number of TCSG Students, USG Students, NSC Students, and the students that did not go to college. Users may click on the title or on a section of the chart to view more detailed information. The drill through report displays the total number of students enrolled in college or university by high school. The report also contains the number of students from the high school that enrolled in the college or university, the average GPA of the students, and the SAT scores. The data is displayed based on the information provided from TCSG, USG, and NSC.

Note: TCSG provided data for all four (Verbal, Math, Critical Thinking, and Writing) SAT categories; USG provided data for two (Verbal & Math) SAT categories. As a result, the total scores may not be accurate.



College Remediation

This report displays the total number of students, the number of students that did not require remediation and the number of students that did require remediation. Users may click on the title or on a section of the chart to view more detailed information. The drill through report displays the total number of students by college or university.
