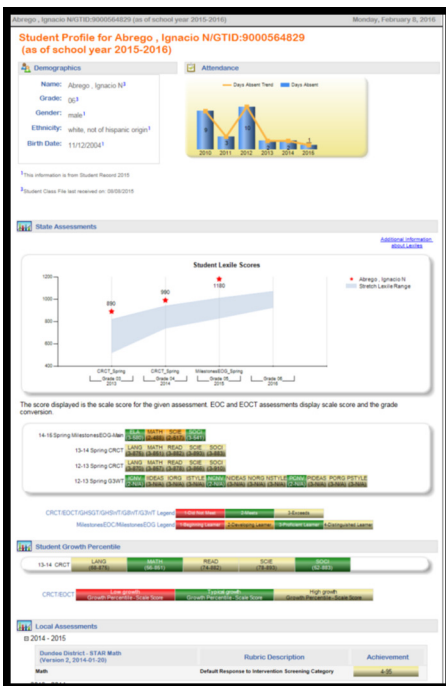



# SLDS in Five Steps or Less

## Exploring the Student Profile Report

1. In SLDS open up a Student Profile report. If you are not familiar with how to access the Student Profile report, click the link below for instructions "[Accessing the Student Profile Page in SLDS](#)".



2. The upper section of the page displays **Demographics** and **Attendance** (historical). This is static information so there is limited drilldown information. However, if the student has the 'Student With Disabilities' **SWD: Y** indicator, click on the **'Y'** and the Special Ed Services Events will display. If your school system uses GO IEP, you may see a link to the student's latest **finalized IEP** located at the top of the screen, just above the Student Profile page.

3. The next section displays Lexile scores for students who have received a Lexile score based on a state assessment. The grey/blue band indicates the stretch Lexile range. The red star  indicates the student's score and can be compared to the range. No drill-down capability here.
4. If applicable, the next sections display **Assessment** scores (EOC, EOG, CRCT, Pre\_K, etc...), Student Growth Percentile (SGP) and **Local Assessment** data. You can drill-down into any of the Assessment data points to access more in-depth information. Note there is no drill-down on SGP data.
5. The last section of the Student Profile report displays the **Student's Schedule** (if available), **Enrollment History** and Grades (**Unofficial Transcript**).
