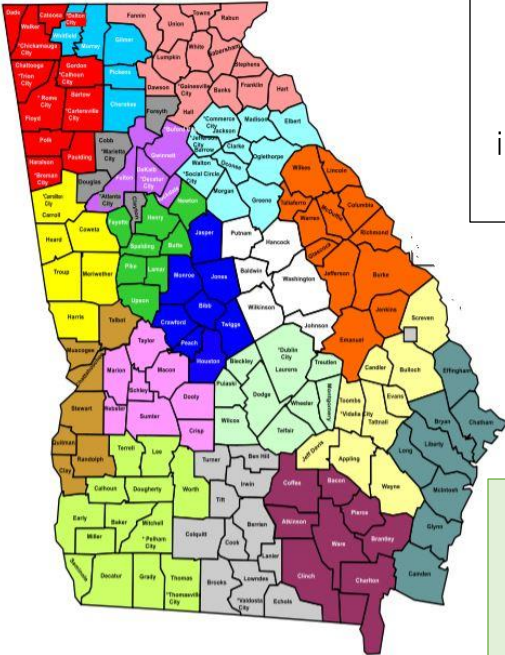

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Regional Programs



Universal professional learning and technical assistance for local school districts around state identified priorities

Targeted technical assistance to support districts with disproportionality
Working to improve graduation rate and achievement of students with disabilities

State-wide GLRS Activity from August 2018 – June 2019

1,007 sessions for *state identified* priorities

2,057 sessions for *regionally identified* priorities

36,551 participants in *3,064* total sessions



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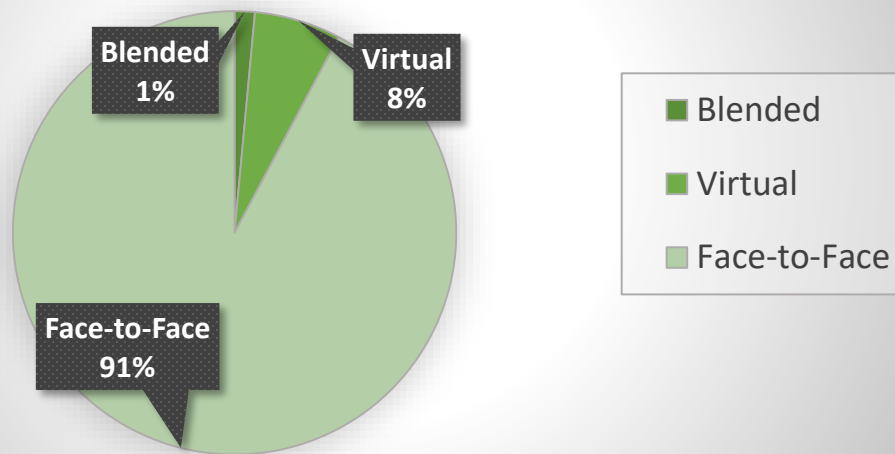
Most Frequent State Priority Professional Learning and Technical Assistance
