

The Accountability Team also publishes the Reward, Priority, Focus, and Alert Schools lists required by the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) Flexibility Waiver of February 6, 2012. Additionally, the Accountability Team publishes the College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) reports for all public school districts and schools.

Each school system has a dedicated Accountability Specialist to serve as a liaison between the Local Education Agency (LEA) and the State Education Agency (SEA) to provide support for all areas of accountability including, but not limited to, interpretation of the reports.










# **Provide CCRPI workshops where school and district leaders and leadership teams can:**


# **Key Advantages of CCRPI**








# A school's weakest domain is often the most heavily weighted section of the test.




### **A District Look at Lexile Performance**




### **Student Growth Percentile Distribution**

**Actions, Strategies, Interventions** 

1. Implement extra learning time for struggling seniors (CCRPI 17-18)

- a) Zero Block -- Before school tutoring
- b) Fifth Block -- After school tutoring
- c) SOS Program (Save Our Seniors) Tutoring during lunch
