- When is the Pre Data Application open?
  - October 11<sup>th</sup> October 31<sup>st</sup>
- What is the purpose of this application?
  - Collect information and pre data from schools who choose to participate in the optional activities for Innovative Practice and Personalized Climate.
- How is information from this application used?
  - The applications provide needed information about the practice/program and baseline data. Post data will be collected in 2017.
- Who can access this application?
  - District Level Users
  - Principal Level Users
- Are schools required to participate in this activity?
  - No, these indicators are optional and schools are not required to participate.





- Information and pre data will be entered on the applicable pre data form(s)
  - Separate forms for innovative practice and personalized climate
  - Provides separate boxes for all required information
- User guide provides <u>critical guidelines</u> and additional information for completing the form(s)
  - Also provides the updated rubrics that will be used to review applications
- CCRPI portal application will be used to submit completed form(s)




#### **School or LEA Defined Innovative Practice**

- Exceeding the Bar indicator #8 for high schools, #5 for middle schools, and #5 for elementary schools:
- School or LEA-defined innovative practice accompanied by data supporting improved student achievement: examples include but are not limited to Charter System, Georgia College and Career Academy, Striving Reader initiative, dual language immersion program, Literacy Design Collaborative (LDC) and/or Mathematics Design Collaborative (MDC), Response to Intervention (RTI), Positive Behavioral Interventions & Supports (PBIS), local instructional initiatives, etc. Practice must be reported via the CCRPI Data Collection application.

#### School or LEA Research/Evidence-Based Program/Practice designed to facilitate a Personalized Climate

- Exceeding the Bar indicator # 9 for high schools, #6 for middle schools and #6 for elementary schools. This data collection also supports additional considerations for the School Climate Star Rating for all school levels.
- School or LEA **Research/Evidence-based Program/Practice** designed to facilitate a **personalized climate** in the school: examples include but are not limited to Teachers as Advisors program; mentoring program; Positive Behavioral Interventions & Supports (PBIS); service-learning program; peer mediation; conflict mediation.

- Select "Edit Document"


