# General Information



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- **When is the Pre Data Application open?**
  - October 11<sup>th</sup> – October 31<sup>st</sup>
- **What is the purpose of this application?**
  - Collect information and pre data from schools who choose to participate in the optional activities for Innovative Practice and Personalized Climate.
- **How is information from this application used?**
  - The applications provide needed information about the practice/program and baseline data. Post data will be collected in 2017.
- **Who can access this application?**
  - District Level Users
  - Principal Level Users
- **Are schools required to participate in this activity?**
  - No, these indicators are optional and schools are not required to participate.
