FIP Foundations for Teachers Course Series

- Includes 5 Foundation Courses

This series includes courses to help teachers learn how to: create and use clear learning targets; collect and document evidence of student learning; use evidence and feedback to increase learning; and foster student ownership of learning.

This course series can be used by teachers in several ways. Three different approaches are listed below:

In a Professional Learning Team (recommended)

Teachers can use the online learning courses and FIP learning resources collaboratively with a team in a coached/facilitated learning environment. This approach provides teachers with a deeper and more structured learning experience.
