Assessment has different purposes and uses in an educational system. Understanding how assessments work together and the role they play in student learning is foundational to effectively using the resulting data. This introductory course explores a high-level view of assessments in student learning as well as the value of a balanced assessment system.

The Georgia Student Assessment Program has many purposes based on assessment design and use of data. Understanding how to interpret, analyze, and use data generated from an assessment is an important skill that can be built through practice. This module explores the many ways that group assessment data can be used and provides a data protocol to build skills around analyzing and using data effectively.



Assessment 101: Data Talk—Understanding and Communicating Assessment Results

Knowing how to understand and use individual assessment data is a refined skill, especially when working with families and students who have a vested interest in the outcome. This module focuses on helping families make sense of assessment data and provides tools and resources to support student learning beyond the classroom. This module features a communication protocol to refine key skills that are important for speaking to families about individual student assessment data.
