The online modules are organized into role-based learning paths that correspond to the participant's responsibilities in the school and district.

Online Learning for Teachers

FIP for Teachers Learning Path

This learning path is designed for teachers and contains Modules 1–5. The path provides foundational information on high-impact assessment practices. Teachers will learn:

- The **components of FIP** and the supporting research.
- How to deconstruct standards into **clear learning targets** for students.
- How to collect and document accurate **evidence of student learning**.
- How to analyze assessment information and provide **effective feedback** to students.
- How to **involve students** in the assessment process via peer feedback, self-assessment, and more.



Online Learning for Instructional Coaches/Teacher Leaders

Coaching FIP for Student Success Learning Path

This learning path is designed for instructional coaches and teachers leaders who will be supporting FIP in their school. The path includes Modules 1–5 and Module 7. This learning path will provide instructional coaches and teacher leaders with a deeper understanding of the core components of FIP and how to help teachers to use these practices in the classroom.



Online Learning for School Leaders

There are two learning path options for school leaders to choose from:

Option 1: Leading FIP for Student Success Learning Path (Recommended)

This learning path is designed for school leaders who will be supporting and leading FIP in their school. The path contains Modules 1–6 and will provide school leaders with a deeper understanding of the core components of FIP and how to affect change in their school. School leaders will learn:

- The **components of FIP** and the supporting research.
- How to **plan for change** and the importance of a **balanced assessment system**.
- How to sustain, support, and lead the **quality implementation** of FIP in a school.

Option 2: FIP Essentials for School Leaders Learning Path

This learning path is designed for school leaders who will be supporting and leading FIP in their school. The path contains Modules 1 and 6. School leaders will learn about the components of FIP and how to affect change in their school.
