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Suicide Awareness Training



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- The new law, HB 198, requires teachers, counselors, and other certified public school personnel to have annual suicide prevention training. The law also requires each school district to adopt a policy on suicide prevention.
- Each school district should plan to send a team of up to five people to receive the training tailored for a redelivery format to one of the five trainings listed to the right.
- More than Sad is a DVD resource that will be mailed to the systems and/or schools in mid to late August for counselors to use with adults as they see fit.
