2017 AP Data

- AP exams completed by students receiving a fee reduction scored at 3 or higher: GA 38%
- AP exams completed by African-American students scored at 3 or higher: GA 30%
- AP exams completed by Hispanic students scored at 3 or higher: GA 47%

2018 AP Data

- AP exams completed by low-income students (Class of 2018) scored at 3 or higher: GA 23.8%
- AP exams completed by African-American students scored at 3 or higher: GA 34%
- AP exams completed by Hispanic students scored at 3 or higher: GA 50%

- Class of 2018 ranked 16th in the nation for scores 3+
- 27,438 AP STEM Exams were funded by the state of Georgia during the 2017-2018 school year.
- 8,878 teachers attended AP Regional Workshops from 2007-2008 to 2017-2018
- 5,022 Advanced Placement teachers were trained using AP Teacher Training Grant funds from 2007-2008 to 2017-2018
