

REVISIONS TO THE DEFINITIONS OF TWO CODE NUMBERS

Please note that the use of the 4 and 5 as the digits on the fifth position in the code number of each course have been revised in response to the changes to the Dual Enrollment Board rule.

XX.XXXX4XX = DUAL ENROLLMENT CREDIT - A 4 as the fifth numerical digit to the right of the decimal indicates that the student ~~s~~**is taking a Dual Credit Course, pursuant to State Board of Education Rule 160-4-2-.34 DUAL ENROLLMENT, and will** receive credit for the course while taking it for dual enrollment credit at an **eligible** postsecondary public or private institution. Students participating in dual enrollment must adhere to the requirements found in State Board of Education Rule 160-4-2-.34 DUAL ENROLLMENT-~~MOVE ON WHEN READY~~. Students may earn units of credit for courses taken at a postsecondary institution through dual enrollment programs for courses that have approved alignment to courses the student previously successfully completed in high school. Refer to the GAfutures <http://www.gafutures.org/> Web site provided by the Georgia Student Finance Commission for specific information regarding the dual enrollment program. Note: Each college determines availability of courses and acceptance of credit.



XX.XXXX5XX = ~~JOINT ENROLLMENT~~ Self-Pay Dual Credit - A 5 as the fifth numerical digit to the right of the decimal indicates that the ~~students are enrolled in postsecondary coursework with an eligible postsecondary institution while continuing to pursue his or her high school diploma, but the student's high school has not agreed to accept the postsecondary coursework as credit toward the student's high school graduation requirements.~~ ~~student~~ is taking a Self-Pay Dual Credit Course, pursuant to State Board of Education Rule 160-4-2-.34 DUAL ENROLLMENT and will receive credit for the course while taking it for self-pay dual enrollment credit at an eligible postsecondary public or private institution. Students participating in ~~joint enrollment~~ self-pay dual enrollment must adhere to the requirements found in State Board of Education Rule 160-4-2-.16 SCHEDULING FOR INSTRUCTION and Rule 160-4-2-.34 DUAL ENROLLMENT. Students are responsible for funding ~~Joint Enrollment~~ self-pay dual credit participation.

State Board Rule 160-4-2-.34 provides the following definitions:

Dual Credit Course – a postsecondary course, including a virtual course, taken by an eligible high school student pursuant to an arrangement at or through an eligible postsecondary institution for which the student receives secondary credit from his or her eligible high school.

Self-Pay Dual Credit Course – a postsecondary course, including a virtual course, taken by an eligible high school student pursuant to an arrangement at or through an eligible postsecondary institution for which the student receives secondary credit from his or her eligible high school and which is not funded using state funds.
