- Anticipating the return of deployed military parents can lead to negative psychological and behavorial outcomes



How You Can Support

- Encourage your students to wear PURPLE - Publically recognize military youth - Ask military parents to volunteer at school by sharing about their job/career

- Have an honor bulletin board to recognize military parents and their children - Lend a listening ear to military youth - Have military youth share their favorite things
