**2019 AP Data**

- AP exams completed by African American students scored at 3 or higher: GA 35%
- AP exams completed by Hispanic students scored at 3 or higher: GA 52%

**2020 AP Data**

- AP exams completed by African American students scored at 3 or higher: GA 43%
- AP exams completed by Hispanic students scored at 3 or higher: GA 60 %
- 65% of all students earned a 3 or higher
