PUBLIC NOTICE OF REQUEST FOR A TYDING WAIVER FOR THE MATHMEMATICS AND SCIENCE PARTNERSHIP GRANT UNDER SECTION 421(b) OF THE GENERAL EDUCATION PROVISIONS ACT

Current, applicable grantees have been previously been notified via personal correspondences including emails and phone calls.

Notice is hereby given that the Georgia Department of Education (GaDOE) is requesting a Tydings Waiver from the United States Department of Education for FY2016 Title II, Part B: Mathematics and Science Partnerships Grants, CFDA Number 84.366.

The Tydings Waiver will allow the GaDOE and the participating partnerships to continue using these funds to deliver high-quality professional development to support student learning and gains in academic achievement in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM). No new initiatives will be implemented. Specifically, the funds will be used to continue supporting the partnerships between the Institutions of Higher Education and the high-need Local Educational Agencies to improve the content knowledge and pedagogical acumen of mathematics and science teachers of grades K-12 in order to improve student achievement.
