The **International Skills Diploma Seal** is awarded to graduating high school students who complete an international education curriculum and engage in extracurricular activities and experiences that foster the achievement of global competencies.

School Application Process

Schools that are applying to offer the International Skills Diploma Seal for the first time must complete the application [here](#) and submit it to pwallace@doe.k12.ga.us by December 15th. Schools that have already been approved do not need to apply for succeeding years. (One-time approval process per school)

School applications will be evaluated via this [rubric](#) and schools will be notified of the status of their application by February 1st.

Student Awarding Process
