

Climate Rating or PBIS Grant Requirement

School climate influences literacy learning (see <http://www.gadoe.org/External-Affairs-and-Policy/Policy/Pages/School-Climate.aspx>)

Applicants must have at least one school with a climate rating of a 4 or 5, and/or be implementing PBIS. You can find the climate ratings for each school on the Georgia Insights webpage here: <http://www.gadoe.org/Georgia-Insights/Pages/School-Climate-Star-Rating.aspx>

On the Fluid Review grant website, each LEA will be asked:

a) Yes or No:

_____ Do you have a school in your system that has a climate rating of 4 or 5?

_____ Are you currently implementing PBIS?

If you answered no to both of the above, you will be asked to upload a plan to either: (1) Work with a school in a mentoring capacity to strengthen the areas showing weakness, or (2) upload the district's plan to improve school climate. The grant proposal narrative should indicate how the LEA-Partnership will improve of climate over time.
