Applicants must have at least one school with a climate rating of a 4 or 5, and/or be implementing PBIS. On the Fluid Review grant website, each LEA will be asked:

a)	Yes or No:
	Do you have a school in your system that has a climate rating of 4 or 5?
	Are you currently implementing PBIS?

If you answered no to both of the above, you will be asked to upload a plan to either: (1)Work with a school in a mentoring capacity to strengthen the areas showing weakness, or (2) upload the district's plan to improve school climate. The grant proposal narrative should indicate how the LEA-Partnership will improve of climate over time.
