School Completion Toolkit “Student Success: Imagine the Possibilities”

Georgia continues to implement a systemic plan to improve graduation outcomes, decrease dropout rates, and increase student achievement for Students with Disabilities.

To assist Local Educational Agencies (LEAs) in implementing their systemic plan, the state is providing a [School Completion Toolkit](#) with robust, evidence-based resources to meet the requirements of IDEA, ESSA and OSEP.

The purpose of the School Completion Toolkit is to provide districts with a roadmap of strategies, interventions, and resources to help students with and without disabilities graduate with a high school diploma.

Check & Connect (An Evidence-based Intervention)

Check & Connect is an intervention used with K-12 students who show early warning signs of disengagement with school and who are at risk of dropping out. At the core of Check & Connect is a trusting relationship between the student and a caring, trained mentor who advocates and challenges the student to keep education salient. Students are referred to Check & Connect when they show warning signs of disengaging from school, such as poor attendance, behavioral issues, and/or low grades.

Georgia Learning Resources System (GLRS) are trained trainers. Training is free. GLRS provides ongoing support to districts who are implementing Check & Connect.

Contact your GLRS to schedule a training or find out more information. Currently over 100 schools are implementing Check & Connect in Georgia.
