



Synopsis of Proposed Amendment to Rule 160-4-7-.16 Georgia Learning Resources System (GLRS)

The State Board of Education Rule 160-4-7-.16 *Georgia Learning Resources System* encompasses 18 technical assistance centers that provide professional learning, technical assistance, and coaching statewide for special education. It is being amended to change the language to remove outdated references such as No Child Left Behind (NCLB) and to be more precise and consistent throughout the rule.

The amendment also aligns the administrative programming to be determined by the regional organizations, eliminates requirements to maintain a materials center, and removes funding requirements using State funds, though will continue to award funding for the operation of the program as funding permits.
