Purpose

To describe Health Services at State Schools.

Applicability

This policy applies to the Atlanta Area School for the Deaf, the Georgia Academy for the Blind and the Georgia School for the Deaf.

Policy

Health Services staff at the three State Schools shall provide necessary health care services to State School students on a routine basis as prescribed by their physicians, or as needed.

General Provisions

1. School Directors shall develop and implement procedures regarding the provision of health care services to students, student supervision and student/staff ratios to be observed during the provision of such services.
2. The Nursing Supervisor in Health Services shall be the custodian of all Health Services' records and is responsible for ensuring that the records are maintained accurately, adhering to and implementing federal and state law and rules, and updating the records in a timely manner.
