Purpose

To describe policies for students at the State Schools to participate in joint enrollment at off campus schools, colleges, technical colleges, and universities.

Applicability

This policy applies to all students at the Atlanta Area School for the Deaf, the Georgia Academy for the Blind and the Georgia School for the Deaf.

Policy

Students who are enrolled in State Schools shall be allowed to participate in joint enrollment at the State Schools and off campus schools.

General Provisions

1. Students who are enrolled at a State School shall be allowed to take classes for credit at an off campus school as needed or as student interest dictates. State School students must be in good academic standing in order to be considered for joint enrollment with public school.
2. A liaison shall be designated at each State School to coordinate the joint enrollment of students at an off campus school. This liaison shall act as a resource to the regular education teacher at the off campus school, and ensure that communication access/interpreter services are provided.
3. The State School liaison shall ensure that communication access and other accommodations as needed are provided to the student in the off campus program setting.
