

# Rule Synopsis

## **160-3-1-.07 TESTING PROGRAMS - STUDENT ASSESSMENT (Initiate)**

160-3-1-.07 TESTING PROGRAMS - STUDENT ASSESSMENT is being amended to eliminate double testing for students for students taking Advanced Placement courses and related exams, and/or students taking International Baccalaureate (IB) courses and exams, by exempting these students from having to take both the End of Course test and the related AP/IB exam.

The rule amendment is due to the following:

- Adds a paragraph that exempts a student from taking the end-of-course assessment for a core subject course if he or she passes an Advanced Placement (AP) course in a related subject and takes the related AP exam or if he or she passes an International Baccalaureate (IB) course in a related subject and takes the related IB exam. Grades earned in Advanced Placement or International Baccalaureate courses, in this situation, shall be used in the state accountability system. All students enrolled in Ninth Grade Literature and Composition, Algebra I, Coordinate Algebra and Biology must take the EOC.
