
Overview of Grade Level Skill



CONTENT AREA: 1ST GRADE SIGHT WORDS

Mrs. Woodard- APTT Class Data- Sight Words

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Practice Activity #1

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Sight Word Cards

1. Choose a sight word that your child needs to learn.
2. Write the word in marker on an index card. (The word should be in all lowercase letters unless it is a proper noun.)
3. Repeat with at least 10 words.
4. Show your child one flashcard at a time, saying the word clearly and asking your child to repeat the word after you.
5. Put the first flashcard face down and repeat the process with the other cards.
6. Flash the cards several times every night until your child can say each word immediately without any help!
7. As your child learns the sight words choose 10 other words and repeat the process.


