

Say the Sum - 3rd grade

Numbers of Players: 2-4

Materials: Deck of Cards (Face cards are worth 10)

How to Play:

1. Deal the cards to each player until all have been dealt. The cards should be face down.
2. Each player should now have a pile of cards, face down.
3. The players flip over their top card at the same time and place them in the middle.
4. The players must then find the sum of the 2 cards.
5. The player to say the correct answer first gets to keep both cards.
6. The game continues until each player's pile of cards is gone.
7. The player with the most cards at the end of the game is the winner.

You can play this game with 3 or 4 people. Instead of finding the sum of only 2 numbers, students will have to add three or four numbers together.

Variation - Say the Difference

How to Play:

8. Deal the cards to each player until all have been dealt. The cards should be face down.
9. Each player should now have a pile of cards, face down.
10. The players flip over their top card at the same time and place them in the middle.
11. The players must then find the difference of the 2 cards.
12. The player to say the correct answer first gets to keep both cards.
13. The game continues until each player's pile of cards is gone.
14. The player with the most cards at the end of the game is the winner.
