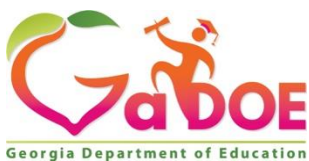

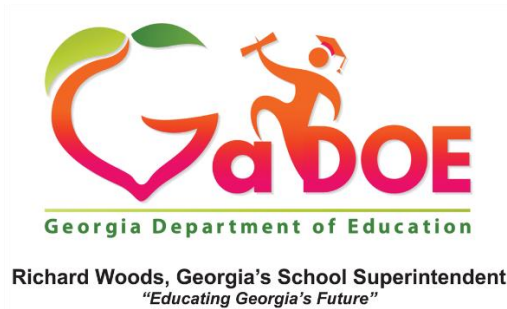

## **DISCLAIMER**

The following equitable services proportionate share allocations for Title I, Part A, Title I, Part C, Title II, Part A, Title III, Part A, Title IV, Part A and Title IV, Part B are preliminary allocations calculated using original FY20 LEA allocations and maximum administrative set-asides. Final allocations are determined at the LEA level through the budget approval process. Changes between the state published allocation and final LEA determined allocation may be attributed to one or more of the following factors:

- LEA transfer of funds (required to be discussed in consultation)
- Approval of administrative set-asides submitted in program budgets (required to be discussed in consultation)
- GaDOE approved carryover of private school funds
- Private schools who withdraw from equitable services
- Increases or decreases in Federal funding following an approved Federal budget
- Changes in state level allocations due to the opening, expansion and/ or closing of state-approved charter schools that are LEAs
