What are Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) and Promise Schools?

- **CSI – Lowest 5%:** the lowest performing 5% of Title I schools in the State when ranked based on their three-year CCRPI average
- **CSI – Graduation Rate:** High schools (Title I or non-Title I) with a four-year adjusted cohort graduation rate less than or equal to 67%
- **Promise Schools:** the 5.01% to 10% lowest performing Title I schools in the State when ranked based on their three-year CCRPI average

CSI & Promise Entrance and Exit Criteria

Criteria Category	Entrance Criteria	Exit Criteria
CSI – Lowest 5%	Title I Schools Only: When ranked according to their three-year CCRPI average, are among the lowest performing 5% of all schools eligible for identification	1) No longer meets entrance criteria AND 2) Demonstrates an improvement greater than or equal to 3% of the gap between the baseline CCRPI score (3-year average that led to identification) and 100. The 3% improvement must be demonstrated from the highest of the three CCRPI scores used to identify the school.

CSI & Promise Entrance and Exit Criteria

Criteria Category	Entrance Criteria	Exit Criteria
CSI – Low Graduation Rate	<p>All High Schools: Have a four-year adjusted cohort graduation rate less than or equal to 67%</p>	Attain a four-year adjusted cohort graduation rate greater than 67%
Promise Schools	<p>Title I Schools Only: When ranked according to their three-year CCRPI average, are among the lowest performing 5% to 10% of all schools eligible for identification</p>	<p>1) No longer meets the greater than 5% to 10% entrance criteria AND 2) The school’s current overall CCRPI score is greater than the baseline CCRPI score (the 3-year average that led to the school’s Identification).</p>

What School Improvement support will Promise schools receive?



- 2) Ongoing collaboration and technical assistance for continuous improvement
- 3) Professional Learning (optional)
- 4) GaDOE District Effectiveness Specialist (DES) to support districts in developing, implementing, and monitoring a plan of support for identified schools
- 5) GaDOE School Effectiveness Specialist (SES) and RESA School Improvement Specialist (SIS) coaching (as capacity allows)
- 6) District and school level reviews and walkthroughs as requested (based upon availability)

What School Improvement support will CSI schools receive?


School and District Effectiveness Support:

- 1) Title I, Part A 1003 School Improvement Allocation
- 2) Ongoing collaboration and technical assistance for continuous improvement
- 3) Professional Learning
- 4) GaDOE District Effectiveness Specialist (DES) to support districts in developing, implementing, and monitoring a plan of support for identified schools
- 5) School-level Continuous Improvement Team (RESA SIS, GaDOE SES, school leadership, and other intermediaries) provides on-site coaching and support around continuous improvement efforts
- 6) School walkthroughs/on-site reviews - GSAPS for newly identified schools and mini GSAPS for returning schools


Will my school enter? CSI Lowest 5% or Promise 5% to 10%




Will my school enter? CSI Graduation Rate



Will my previously identified school exit? CSI Lowest 5%



Did my school make the 3% gain?



Calculate the 3% of the gap between the 3-year average score and 100

$$\begin{aligned} &.03(100-52.4667) \\ &.03(47.533) \\ &1.425999 \\ &1.4 \leftarrow 3\% \text{ Gap Change} \end{aligned}$$

Add the 3% Gap Change to the highest of the 3 scores
 $56.8 + 1.4 = 58.2$



Target Score = 58.2

The CCRPI score must be greater than or equal to 58.2 for the school to meet the 3% gain

Any single year score needs to be greater than the target score – provided the school is NOT in the bottom 5% of Title I schools.

What are Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) Schools and Additional Targeted Support (ATSI) Schools?

- Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI)
 - Consistently Underperforming Subgroup - all schools that have at least one subgroup that is performing in the lowest 5% of all schools in at least 50% of CCRPI components
 - Additional Targeted Support - among all schools identified for Consistently Underperforming Subgroup, have at least one subgroup that is performing in the lowest 5% of all schools in all CCRPI components

TSI and ATSI Entrance and Exit Criteria

Criteria Category	Entrance Criteria	Exit Criteria
TSI – Consistently Underperforming Subgroup	All Schools: Have at least one subgroup that is performing in the lowest 5% of all schools in at least 50% of CCRPI components.	A school may exit if no subgroup is performing in the lowest 5% of all schools in at least 50% of CCRPI components.
ATSI – Additional Targeted Support	All Schools: Among all schools identified for consistently underperforming subgroup, have at least one subgroup that is performing in the lowest 5% of all schools in all CCRPI components. Note: Title I schools identified for additional targeted support will move to the CSI list if they do not meet the TSI exit criteria after three consecutive years.	A school may exit if no subgroup is performing in the lowest 5% of all schools in all CCRPI components AND the subgroup’s current score is greater than the previous score for all components in which the subgroup is no longer in the lowest 5%.



Will my school enter? TSI Consistently Underperforming Subgroup or TSI Additional Targeted Support



My school is on the 2018-2019 TSI list. Will my school exit?

- Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI)
 - Consistently Underperforming Subgroup - If a school was on the 2018-2019 TSI list and is not on the 2019-2020 TSI list, then the school exits TSI status
 - Additional Targeted Support - If a school was on the 2018-2019 ATSI list and is not on the 2019-2020 ATSI list, and the 2019 subgroup component score is greater than the 2018 subgroup component score for all components, then the school exits ATSI status

The Accountability Division serves to provide all stakeholders with important information on the performance and progress of Georgia schools, districts, and the state. The division also improves communication between all Georgia public schools and stakeholders regarding federal and state education accountability initiatives. The division is also responsible for ensuring the state meets the accountability requirements of the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). Finally, the division publishes the College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) reports. Each school system has a dedicated Accountability Specialist to serve as a liaison between the Local Education Agency (LEA) and the State Education Agency (SEA) to provide support for all areas of accountability including, but not limited to, interpretation of the reports.
