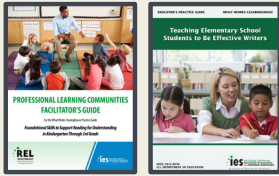

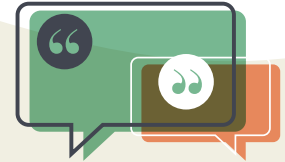

- At every level from early childhood to postsecondary education

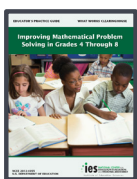


- On topics beyond academic content, such as student dropout
