SUBJECT: Georgia Milestones Nomination of Educators for Item and Data Review

The Georgia Department of Education (GaDOE) is seeking nominations for highly-qualified educators to participate in the upcoming Georgia Milestones Assessment System Item and Data Review Workshop. This meeting is scheduled for **October 27-29, 2014**. The sessions will be held from **8:00 am to 4:00 pm** at a hotel in the Atlanta area. This event includes two major tasks:

- 1. Participants will review potential future field-test items for content, bias, sensitivity, depth of knowledge, and alignment to Georgia's state-adopted content standards for English Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies.
- 2. Participants will review the performance data for items that were field tested during the Spring 2014 administrations.

The actual dates will vary by content area and grade level or course. Please refer to the charts below:

To ensure that an adequate representation of educators from around Georgia is selected, System Test Coordinators and/or System Curriculum Coordinators should submit the names of highly-qualified teachers in the above-mentioned content areas and/or courses. We are also seeking highly-qualified educators in special education and ESOL with experience in the content areas/courses noted above. Please submit **6 nominations per system**. Participants will be selected to ensure a representative sample across the state based on grade level and content area. Please consider educators from your system who:

- 1) demonstrate depth of knowledge in their content area;
- 2) demonstrate instructional expertise;
- 3) increase student achievement through the use of proven, research-based practices;
- 4) participate in ongoing professional learning;
- 5) provide leadership among their colleagues;
- 6) represent the ethnic and regional diversity of your system;
- 7) teach diverse and/or exceptional student populations, including vision/hearing impaired students;
- 8) receive recognition for their contributions to teaching and learning; and
- 9) bring a fresh perspective to the Georgia Milestones Assessment System development process.

To ensure a balanced, representative committee, not all nominees will be selected. Systems are encouraged to nominate first-time participants.

Please submit nominations during the period August 22 – September 5, 2014. It is imperative that participants selected for these sessions be committed to attending the entire time. Due to the overwhelming response to these events, **nomination <u>does not</u> guarantee participation**. Only those who receive an official invitation from CTB/McGraw-Hill via email may attend the workshop. Further, it is also important for all nominees to be aware that they <u>must</u> attend every day of the event as indicated above.

Participants will be notified the week of September 15, 2014 if they have been selected to participate in this event. Once selected, participants will be contacted with hotel registration information. Nominees not selected to participate will also be notified once the participant list is finalized. Until such time, those not selected are considered as alternates for participation.

NOMINATION PROCESS

- 1. Establish a nominee pool; the nominee's direct supervisor(s) should approve participation.
- 2. Collect information needed to complete a nomination survey.
- 3. The last page of this memorandum is a template that can be emailed between the school system and nominees to collect information needed for the survey.
- Fill out one online nomination form for each nominee no later than Friday, September 5, 2014, using the following link: https://www.surveymonkey.com/s/Item Review Nomination Form
- 5. Nomination information will be submitted by the GA Milestones vendor, CTB/McGraw-Hill, to the Georgia Department of Education. Approved nominees will receive an email invitation to the workshop the week of September 15, 2014 and will be required to send a response within 72 hours. Only those who receive a final confirmation letter may attend the workshop. Nominees not initially selected will remain as alternates until panels are finalized but will be notified the week of September 29, 2014 as well.

Please Note: Only System Test Coordinators and/or System Curriculum Coordinators may submit nominees using the survey link provided.

As you recruit nominees, please inform them that certain costs are covered. Substitute reimbursements to the local school/system will be made for the actual cost of providing the classroom substitute, but not for any additional fees incurred by the system (such as to a vendor) to procure substitutes. Mileage will be reimbursed at the rate stipulated in current state travel regulations. If a participant meets the criteria provided in state travel regulations for hotel accommodations, lodging will be covered as well. Breakfast and lunch are provided as part of the meeting. For those who are eligible, dinner reimbursement is for an amount up to \$20.00.
