SUBJECT: Georgia Alternate Assessment (GAA) Fall 2015 Training

In preparation for the 2015-2016 administration of the GAA, the Georgia Department of Education (GaDOE) will be conducting pre-assessment training online in August 2015. The purpose of these webinars is to provide information to guide the appropriate system-level and school-level staff in the development of portfolios that showcase the achievement and progress of students with significant cognitive disabilities. Representatives from the GaDOE and Questar Assessment, Inc. will be presenting the sessions. The specific dates/times and links to access both the live broadcasts and recorded sessions are listed on the following pages.

A variety of topics will be addressed during five broadcasts held on four dates. The duration of the sessions varies; each will allow time for questions and answers. The topics selected were identified based upon an analysis of 2014-2015 GAA results and feedback from school and system personnel. We will also address important administrative and curriculum access topics. The last session will be devoted to questions from the online audience. Please refer to the following pages for a list of topics to be addressed along with date/time information and the links to use in pre-registering for the sessions.

A target audience is defined for each session based upon the topics. However, System Test Coordinators are expected to collaborate with their Special Education Coordinator to determine the appropriate attendees for your district. The fact that each session will be available through both a live delivery and a recording (that can be viewed at any time) will allow systems to schedule the viewing of each session as local schedules may require.
