SUBJECT: Criterion-Referenced Competency Tests – <u>Modified</u> (CRCT-M) Online Ordering System

(TestTime)

The purpose of this memorandum is to introduce the use of TestTime, the online ordering system for Georgia's Criterion-Referenced Competency Tests - Modified (CRCT-M). Systems will use TestTime to:

- verify shipping addresses and contact information;
- provide CRCT-M spring testing dates, spring break dates, and retest dates;
- request CRCT-M test booklets;
- request Braille and Large Print format materials.
