SUBJECT: Kindergarten Teacher Training for GKIDS Readiness Check

As a follow-up to the February 17, 2017, memo regarding the operational launch of the Georgia Kindergarten Inventory of Developing Skills (GKIDS) Readiness Check, below is additional information on training designed specifically for kindergarten teachers.

Remember that this operational launch will involve administering the GKIDS Readiness Check to all kindergarten students statewide at the beginning of the 2017-18 school year.
