SUBJECT: Georgia Milestones Nomination of Educators for Test Development Activities

The Georgia Department of Education (GaDOE) is seeking nominations for educators to participate in several upcoming Georgia Milestones Assessment System meetings and workshops for the End of Grade (EOG) and End of Course (EOC) measures for all four content areas: English Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies. Throughout the summer and fall months, there will be several meetings and GaDOE is seeking to broaden its pool of potential participants.

To ensure that an adequate representation of educators from around Georgia is selected, System Test Coordinators and/or System Curriculum Coordinators should submit the names of highly-qualified teachers in the above-mentioned content areas and/or the courses assessed. We are also seeking highly-qualified educators in special education and ESOL with experience in the content areas/courses assessed. Districts may submit up to **10 nominations**; we ask that you submit names across a range of grade levels and courses. Please consider educators from your district who:

- 1) demonstrate depth of knowledge in their content area;
- 2) demonstrate instructional expertise;
- 3) increase student achievement through the use of proven, research-based practices;
- 4) participate in ongoing professional learning;
- 5) provide leadership among their colleagues;
- 6) represent the gender, ethnic and regional diversity of your system;
- 7) teach diverse and/or exceptional student populations, including vision/hearing impaired students;
- 8) receive recognition for their contributions to teaching and learning; and
- 9) bring a fresh perspective to the Georgia Milestones Assessment System development process.

In preparation for each meeting or workshop, GaDOE will select participants to ensure a representative sample across the state based on grade level and content area. To ensure a balanced, representative committee, not all nominees will be selected. Districts are encouraged to nominate first-time participants.

Please submit nominations, using the link provided below, during the period April 15 – May 15, 2015. Nomination does not guarantee invitation to an event. Only those who receive an official invitation for an event from CTB/McGraw-Hill via email may attend a workshop.

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NOMINATION PROCESS

- 1. Establish a nominee pool; the nominee's direct supervisor(s) should approve participation.
- 2. Collect information needed to complete a nomination survey.
- 3. The last page of this memorandum is a template that can be emailed between the school system and nominees to collect information needed for the survey.
- 4. Fill out one online nomination form for each nominee **no later than Friday, May 15, 2015,** using the following link: https://www.surveymonkey.com/s/ga nominations
- 5. Nomination information will be submitted by the Georgia Milestones vendor, CTB/McGraw-Hill, to the Georgia Department of Education.

Please Note: Only System Test Coordinators and/or System Curriculum Coordinators may submit nominees using the survey link provided.

As you recruit nominees, please inform them that certain workshop costs are covered. Substitute reimbursements to the local school/system will be made for the actual cost of providing the classroom substitute, but not for any additional fees incurred by the system (such as to a vendor) to procure substitutes. Mileage will be reimbursed at the rate stipulated in current state travel regulations. If a participant meets the criteria provided in state travel regulations for hotel accommodations, lodging will be covered as well. Breakfast and lunch are provided as part of the meeting. For those who are eligible, dinner reimbursement is for an amount up to \$20.00. During the summer months, an honorarium is offered for teachers not under contract.

Specific meeting details will be provided when the event invitation is sent. Invited educators must confirm their availability to attend and will be provided instructions to do so.
