MOWR Early Graduation Option



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- **Earn a high school diploma (SB 2)**
 - Student must receive credit for all End of Pathway courses: two English, two math, two science, and two social studies, and the required PE and Health course
 - **Note: Course(s) may be taken through MOWR and/or at high school**
 - **Take EOC exams**
 - **Exams must count 20% of final grade**
 - Earn and complete one of the following:
 - **Associate degree**
 - **Technical diploma**
 - **Two certificate programs within one specific career pathway**
 - The high school must award a high school diploma

MOWR Updates & Reminders



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1. MOWR students are still high school students
2. Local system makes final decision on **what, how, when, where** and **If** MOWR courses are taught at their high school instead of colleges
3. Be consistent with procedures, schedules, and expectations of MOWR students as non-MOWR students
4. Not required to pay college part of your FTE for MOWR participation
5. Local systems earns and retains their FTE funding
6. MOWR students can be enrolled beyond fulltime at the high school

MOWR Updates & Reminders



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1. Grades **must be posted** on high school transcripts, even if student withdraws from MOWR courses
2. MOWR regulation 1605.5f. The high school must record on the student's high school transcript each approved course name, **grade**, and amount of credit hours and course unit credits earned for each course taken as a Dual Credit Enrollment student
3. Systems can pursue local articulation agreements

MOWR Updates & Reminders



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1. Math-first 3 required math courses (Alg. I, Geometry, Alg. II) are not available for any MOWR courses. MOWR approved mathematics courses are awarded core/elective credit for the fourth mathematics course requirement beyond Algebra II. Generic numbers are for 4th math or elective credit

GAfutures.org is almost ready to go and there are a few things we'd like to remind you about as we put the finishing touches on Georgia's newest resource to help students prepare for college.

Tip#1 All Website Access Temporarily Unavailable

GAcollge411 will be retired July 20 @ 5 p.m. There will be no access to SURFER/STARS, Transcript Exchange, HOPE GPA Reporting, GSFC financial aid applications (GSFAPPS, MOWR) and college admissions applications accessed through GAcollge411 until July 26 when GAfutures is launched.

Tip#2 Financial Aid Applications

Encourage students to complete financial aid applications prior to July 20 @ 5 p.m. if they have deadlines between July 20 and July 26. All applications will be available again through GAfutures July 26.



Tip#3 Transcripts - High School

Complete reviews and verifications of HOPE GPA calculations for seniors before July 15. The GPA calculation process will stop at this time then resume once GAfutures is live July 26. The Transcript Exchange function will be accessed through STARS from the GAfutures homepage

Tip#4 Transcripts - Postsecondary

Download all transcripts for your college from the Control Center by July 20 @ 5 p.m. Access to transcripts released to your college will be through SURFER via GAfutures on July 26.

MOWR Funding



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- 1) FY16 \$48 Million not including this summer
- 2) FY17 \$58 Million includes this summer through next spring
- 3) Payment made per student:
 - a. Full tuition charges-Public colleges
 - b. Private college-\$250 per semester or \$187 per quarter
 - c. Mandatory fee-\$50
 - d. Book funds-\$25 per hour up to 15 semester or 12 quarter hours per term
- 4) One MOWR student taking one course through:
 - a. TCSG-Tuition \$201, \$75 books, \$50 Mandatory fee=\$326
 - b. USG-Tuition \$699, \$75 books, \$50 Mandatory fee=\$824

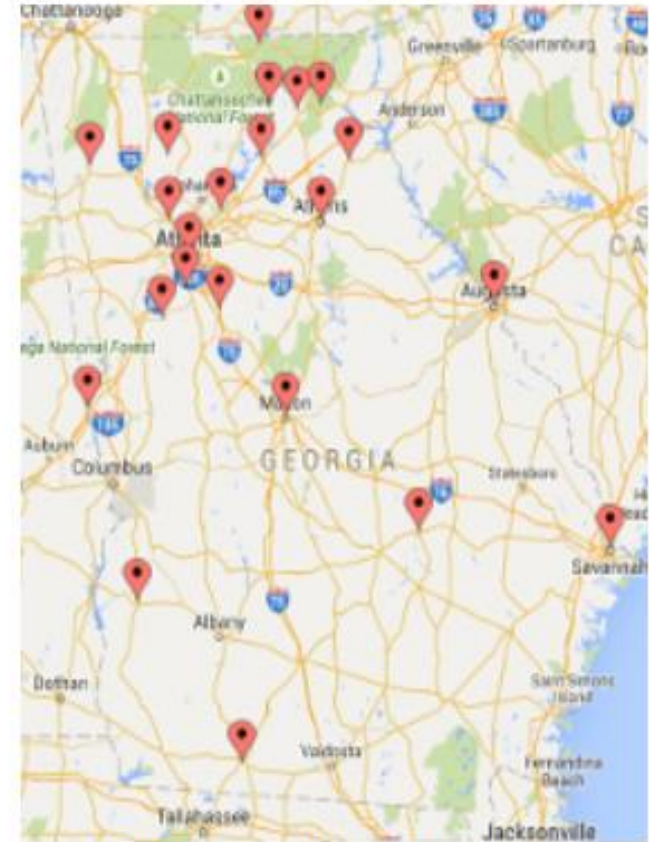
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Move On When Ready
