
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FY2018 EOPA District Summary & Sign Off Reports


- Should have reviewed/verified reports before they were submitted by the superintendent
- Reports are still on the EOPA Portal
- Print a copy of the EOPA District Summary & Sign Off Report
- Print a copy of the EOPA Eligibility Report
 - keep in a safe, secure location
- Unable to send copies of the district's EOPA data via email
- All new CTAE Administrators:
 - Obtain permission from superintendent and request that your local Security Officer provision you to have access (read only) to the EOPA Portal

- After the CAR Report has been signed off on in December
- EOPA Portal is accessed through the GaDOE Portal

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FY2019 EOPA Eligible Students

- Only those students who have successfully completed:
 - all three designated courses in the pathway are considered pathway completers
 - Should be tested in the year that student completes final course

FY2019 Technical Skill Attainment Inventory

- **Updates (additions)** to FY19 Technical Skill Attainment Inventory are pending:
 - **SREB Study** that examines how assessments are added - in the final stages
 - **Senate Bill 3** – The CONNECT Act
 - A statewide committee has been convened to develop/establish procedural guidelines for vetting and adding new EOPA exam options
- More to come this fall
- Currently, inventory remains the same

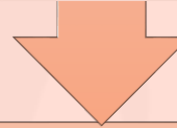

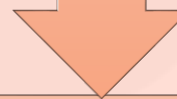

FY2019 Industry Certification Grant Notifications

- 86 applications received

FY2019 Industry Certification Grant Notification Status

- Grant Notification email may show a different certification status:
 - Initial Certification
 - Re-certification
- If grant status notification was different:
 - GaDOE grant database showed a different status
 - Certification status updates are obtained from certifying agencies
 - State funding amounts are archived





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FY2019 Industry Certification Completion Process

- **Reminders:**
 - **Grant Timeline: July 1, 2018 - June 30, 2019**
 - **Program must be certified within fiscal year of grant award**
- CTAE Administrator must work with instructors to ensure completion of process
- All instructors in approved programs must attend an industry certification workshop
