

FAFSA COMPLETION



FAFSA Completion: Benefits

- Identify individual students who have and have not completed the FAFSA.
- Provide aggregate data by school and district of FAFSA completions.
- Students seeking higher education will become more knowledgeable of the availability of financial aid.
- Postsecondary institutions can use the aggregate data in recruiting efforts for first generation or low-income students.
- Verification that students enrolling in postsecondary institutions are prepared to pay for the expenses of college.
- Increased FAFSA numbers = Increased postsecondary enrollment.



FAFSA Completion: Georgia

- 2011-2012 data collected to serve as baseline.
- Aggregate data accessible from GAcollege411.
- Reports updated weekly with most recent FAFSA completion information.
- Individual FAFSA completion status posted in STARS 2.0 accessible through GAcollege411 behind sign on.



Georgia's Source for FAFSA Completion Data

Completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is one of the most important steps students and their families must take to receive state and federal grants, scholarships and loans to help pay for college, career school or graduate school.

Georgia's FAFSA Completion project is sponsored by the Georgia Student Finance Commission (GSFC) and was developed to increase FAFSA completion rates throughout Georgia and thereby increases the number of students attending college or other postsecondary institution. By providing access to the FAFSA completion rates for schools and districts across the state, this initiative intends to promote the importance of completing the FAFSA through education and a competitive environment.


