



CONSEQUENSES OF SEQUESTRATION Federal Perkins Funds

- Congress did not pass a budget in January 2012
- Sequestration becomes law August 2012
- These automatic reductions mandated by the Budget Control Act are expected to cut roughly \$1 trillion from our nation's deficit in the next 10 years
- Goes into effect January 1, 2013. Postponed till March. We receive our state allocation in two payments (July1 and October 1). July 1 is 25% of total allocation and October 1 is remaining 75%. Georgia has always allocated 100% at June SBOE Meeting
- A reduction of up to 14% could occur to your FY2014 allocation in July 2013

FY2013 Reduction Of State Funds

- •The Office of Planning and Budget is recommending a 3% reduction in current FY2013 funding
- Reduction must be approved by the legislature
- •CTE Extended Day and Extended Year funds have been frozen until the amended FY2013 budget is approved
- •You should have only drawn down approximately 60% of these funds
- •We will advise you of your new allocation if the reduction passes
- •Please make your Finance Director aware of this information.
