Brochure includes all of Georgia's Dual Credit Programs to inform 8th-11th grade students

High School Student Participation in Dual Enrollment
Participation in Dual Enrollment/Dual Credit programs eases the transition from high school to college, provides students an early start to their college careers, and offers meaningful and challenging academic experiences to qualified students, including those who might not otherwise have access to early college opportunities.

Dual Enrollment may help increase the number of high school graduates who are both college and career ready.

Approved courses must count toward state and/or local high school graduation requirements.

Dual Enrollment information should be provided to all 8th through 11th grade students and parents by April 1 of each school year.

Georgia's Dual Enrollment/Dual Credit Programs for High School Students

Dual Enrollment/Dual Credit courses provide opportunities for Georgia high school students to take college-level courses and earn concurrent credit toward a high school diploma and a college degree.

Dual Enrollment/Dual Credit courses are primarily available for any eligible 11th or 12th grade (in some limited cases 9th-10th) high school students. They may enroll full-time or part-time in approved credit-bearing college-level courses by the State Board of Education. Courses may be taken before, during or after regular school hours, on the college campus, on-line or at the high school during the regular school calendar year.
