

# Guidelines to Determine Eligible Colleges For Move on When Ready

1. Any participating unit of the University System of Georgia.
2. Any participating branch of the Technical College System of Georgia.
3. A participating private, nonprofit postsecondary school that meets ALL of the following criteria:
  - Is located in Georgia;
  - Is not part the University System of Georgia;
  - Is currently accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools, holds candidate for accreditation status with the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools, or was accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools within the past seven years;
  - Is not a graduate level school or college of theology or divinity; and
  - Is not currently receiving state funds as a junior college as part of the Junior College Program of the State of Georgia.
4. A participating private, for-profit postsecondary school that meets ALL of the following criteria:
  - Is located in Georgia;
  - Is a baccalaureate degree-granting institution;
  - Is accredited by a regional accrediting agency recognized by the United States Department of Education;
  - Is not a Bible school or college;
  - Admits as regular students only individuals that have obtained a high school diploma, general educational development diploma (GED), or a degree from an accredited postsecondary institution;
  - Whose students are eligible to participate in the federal Pell Grant program;
  - Has been reviewed by the Georgia Nonpublic Postsecondary Education Commission and approved for operation and for receipt of tuition equalization grant funds; and
  - Has been in existence for at least ten years.
