

- Provide GaDOE Guidance on using Entrepreneurship in WBL. A task force is being formed to study the possibilities and provide guideline and suggestions for inclusion in the WBL Manual



Initiatives

- Focus on existing economy of Rural areas such as Agriculture and Tourism
- Find a way fund a full time WBL coordinator that can create "real" placements
- Partnerships with government agencies
- Utilize industry groups that support workforce development in rural areas
- Collaboration with TCSG and their registered apprenticeship opportunities
- Seek alternatives to related coursework: dual enrollment, online courses, virtual school
- Look at barriers such as transportation issues and formulate solutions
